Policy Name: Test Proctoring Policy

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to address requests for test proctoring services in the TWU Libraries. When applicable, the TWU Libraries will adhere to the University's policy. However, additional guidelines specific to the TWU Libraries are also included in this Library policy.

Note: Access, availability, usage, and occupancy limits may be changed in accordance with University guidelines regarding health and safety.

Definitions: For the purpose of this policy

Proctored Exam– tests/exams where the student(s) are monitored in some way while taking the exam

Policy:

- 1. Most commonly students on all campuses should contact their professor for specific proctoring instructions or regulations on where they might need to take their exams.
- 2. Students registered with Disability Support Services may request proctoring from the DSS office. CFO 106, 940-898-3835.
- 3. Dallas and Houston students may request proctoring from the Disability Support Services (DSS) office. CFO 106, 940-898-3835.

An examination proctoring service is not available from the TWU Libraries. Library staff cannot devote time to carefully monitoring test takers, and appropriate spaces for examinations are not available.
