EDUCATION For education students (grades 4 through 8), the Field of Study courses are EDUC 1301, EDUC 2301, MATH 1350, and MATH 1351. For education students (Early Childhood through Grade 6), the Field of Study courses are TECA 1303, 1311 and 1354. Field of Study courses are lower-division courses which must be accepted in transfer to state colleges and universities. Incoming transfer students will not be required to repeat courses with the same content as field of study courses.

GOV Prefix - Acceptable course combinations/Texas Common Course Numbers GOVT 2305 (TWU GOV 2013) and GOVT 2306 (TWU GOV 2023). Collin offers the acceptable course combination/TCCNS of GOVT 2301 and GOVT 2302. Combination of a course from one sequence combination with a course from another sequence may not successfully fulfill the state government requirement content requirement.

RVW* The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board has designated WECM (workforce education and technical vocation courses) as offered for credit and continuing education units. These courses are not designed to automatically transfer to public four-year colleges and universities.

TWU will review these courses on a case-by-case basis since certain degree programs (including BAAS) may apply the course work toward meeting degree requirements. In other cases, elective credit may be awarded.

TITL Credit is accepted, however no exact equivalent is available at TWU. Major/minor programs will decide how best to use the credit in order to fulfill degree requirements. Consult with your academic advisor at TWU.

TWU will accept credit upon review for every one of its degree programs on a case-by-case basis since degree programs may apply the course work towards meeting degree requirements.
