Application Checklist

I. General Requirements

- Must be an employee of FWISD – a 4th, 5th grade or secondary content area (math, science, social studies or ELA) teacher with some students who are English Language Learners in the content area classes.
- Must commit to teach for FWISD for a minimum of 2 years beginning with the first semester of Project ACCELERATE classes.
- Must be a permanent resident or citizen of the United States.

II. Application to Texas Woman’s University

- Complete online application for Graduate Admission (as non-degree seeking)
 - o Go to https://www.applytexas.org/adappc/gen/c_start.WBX
 - o Create an account by filling out the information requested.
 - o When asked to select major, select “Administration (MEd)” and continue filling out the form.
 - o Under the **Educational Background** are, line 17 says “Degree you will seek” and from the drop down menu, select “Non-Degree” and continue with the application.
- Mail to Project ACCELERATE office (address below) official transcripts of Bachelor’s Degree and any additional undergraduate and graduate coursework. *Individuals with degrees from a foreign university must provide certified English translation of transcripts and diploma.*

III. Application to Project ACCELERATE – Mail the following documents to Project ACCELERATE office:

- Recommendation form signed by your principal
- Complete application for Project ACCELERATE
