The N² Texas Corps is an AmeriCorps program operated by CitySquare. Members provide critical support to thousands of children by serving in one of two areas: education and hunger.

AmeriCorps is not a job, it's a chance to really make a difference in the community. In exchange for your service, members receive a living allowance and an end of term education award. Don't miss this opportunity to make your world better!

AmeriCorps Member

The N² Texas Corps will place 230 summer AmeriCorps members across twelve programs in Dallas, Austin, San Antonio, and Houston. Each program has a different requirement but all share the common mission to educate and enrich our community's youth.. Members receive an \$1,800 living allowance and an end of term education award of \$1,175. Members sign up for a 8-12 week summer term and agree to serve 300-330 hours of service in order to receive all benefits.

The Education Corps Programs: Targets youth at risk of school failure by focusing on educational attainment through structured summer programs. Members are placed with one of 12 partner agencies throughout Dallas. Daily activities vary between sites but all share the common mission to educate and enrich our community's youth. Applicants must be energetic, have an interest in working with school-aged youth, and serve as a positive role model. Summer members serve 30-40 hrs/wk and must be available Mon through Fri between 9am and 5pm.

Food on the Move (Summer Only): Every summer hundreds of thousands of children in Texas go hungry when school lets out and they lose access to free lunch programs. Members serving with Food on the Move combat childhood hunger by providing meals in a mobile feeding program targeting youth at low-income apartment sites. Applicants must be willing to serve outside all day, be energetic, have an interest in working with school-aged youth and travel daily between sites.
