CDM currently partners with over 15 local organizations by providing AmeriCorps members to expand and enhance existing programs. Summer members are placed with one of these organizations to help provide summer enrichment programming to at-risk youth in the Dallas area.

Application Process:

- Submit completed Application by deadline
- Attend an AmeriCorps orientation session
- Complete a second interview with host site
- Receive follow-up call regarding placement

Service Requirements:

- **300 hours** of service (*minimum*)
- Serve over a 10-week period;
June through August 2010
- Attend a mandatory three day kick-off training and service project **June 3-5, 2010**

Minimum Qualifications:

- At least 17 years old by June 3, 2010
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- High School Diploma or Equivalency
- Ability to perform minimum service hours between June and August

- **\$1,800** Living Stipend (paid over the term)
- **\$1,000** Education Award
- Training through *Dallas After School Network*
