**Internship Overview:** Casa de Esperanza is a leading provider of residential foster care services to very young children, ages birth to six years old, whose families are experiencing crises that impede their ability to safely care for their children. Casa de Esperanza operates ten agency homes, staffed by full-time, live-in volunteer house parents who care for the children in a warm, family home setting. The summer internship, sponsored by Exxon Mobil, allows a college student the opportunity to join our team of full-time volunteers for the summer, caring for abused, neglected and HIV-affected children in their role as volunteer child care intern. Duties for the summer include: living with and caring for up to six foster children; accompany children living in your home to all medical, dental, rehabilitative and family visit appointments; represent the agency to all community volunteers and funding groups; maintain household premises through routine chores and housework; maintain compliance with all required paperwork; other duties as specified.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- 21 years old by June 1, 2010
- currently enrolled, full-time (minimum of 12 hours), undergraduate having completed at least their freshman year.
- returning to school in the fall of 2010 as a full-time sophomore, junior, or senior.
- not related to any employee or permanent contractor of ExxonMobil.

**Internship length:** 8 weeks

**Internship stipend:** \$2,750
