MISSION STATEMENT

The mission of the Community Supervision and Corrections Department of Tarrant County is:

- *to protect the public interest and safety of the community by supervising individuals placed on community supervision by the judges of the Criminal Courts of Tarrant County.*

Community supervision services will include:

- *enforcing the orders of the courts;*
- *providing services which meet the needs of offenders to assist them in becoming law abiding citizens; and*
- *participation in programs and activities designed to reduce the impact of crime in Tarrant County.*

In addition, the Community Supervision and Corrections Department will:

- *provide services to victims of crime in Tarrant County; and*
- *strive to inform and educate the public concerning the philosophy and role of community corrections.*



COURT SERVICES

Court Services conducts pre- and post-sentence investigations by interviewing defendants in court. They receive probationers in court and advise them of the conditions of community supervision. They participate in court proceedings, including trials, bond and competency hearings.

SUPERVISION

The Supervision branch accepts monthly reports from probationers and determines level of compliance with conditions of supervision. They issue referrals for service, and obtain and test UAs. They also prepare reports of violations. They prepare reviews for early release for submission to the Court.
