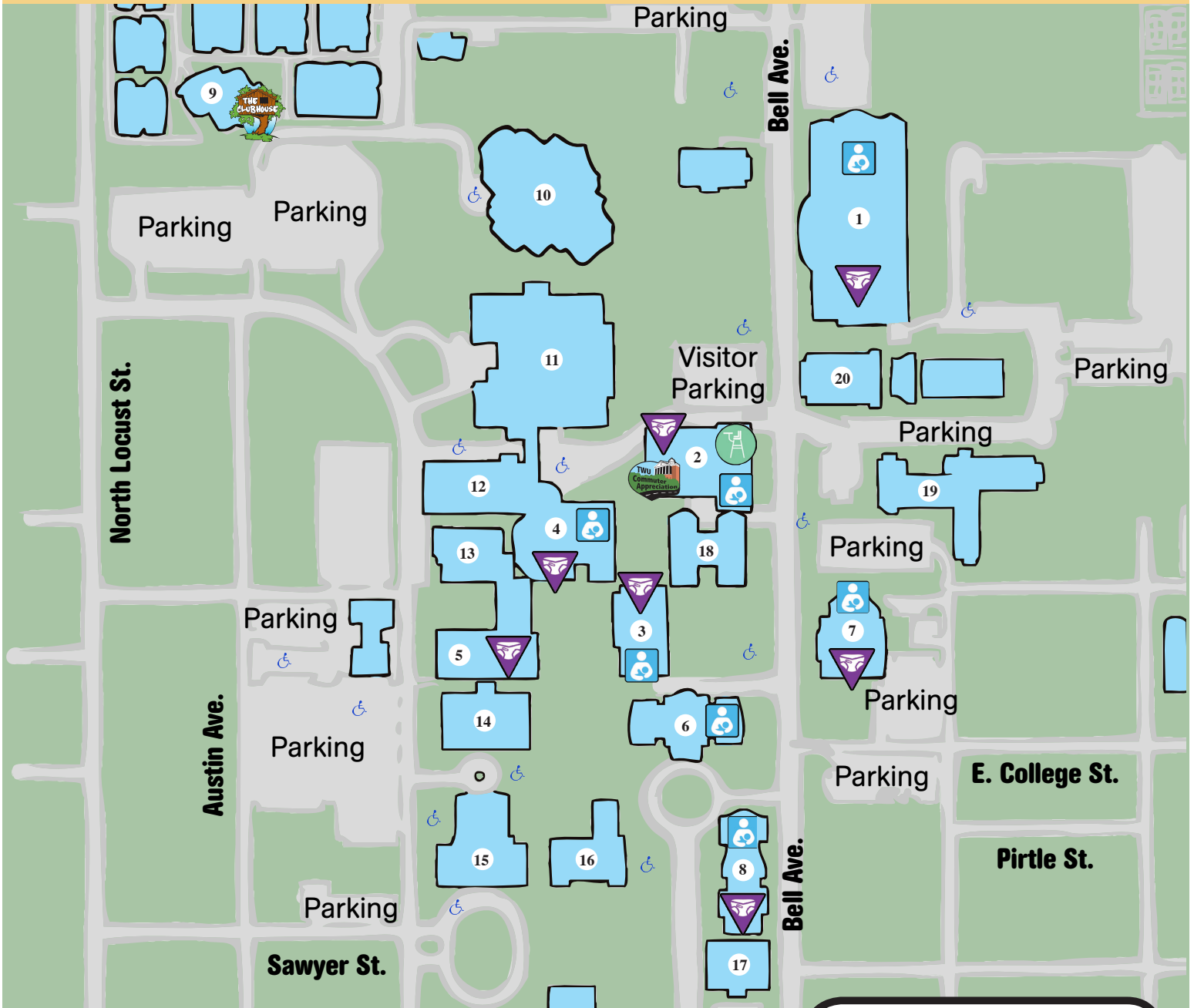








TWU PARENT FRIENDLY CAMPUS MAP
