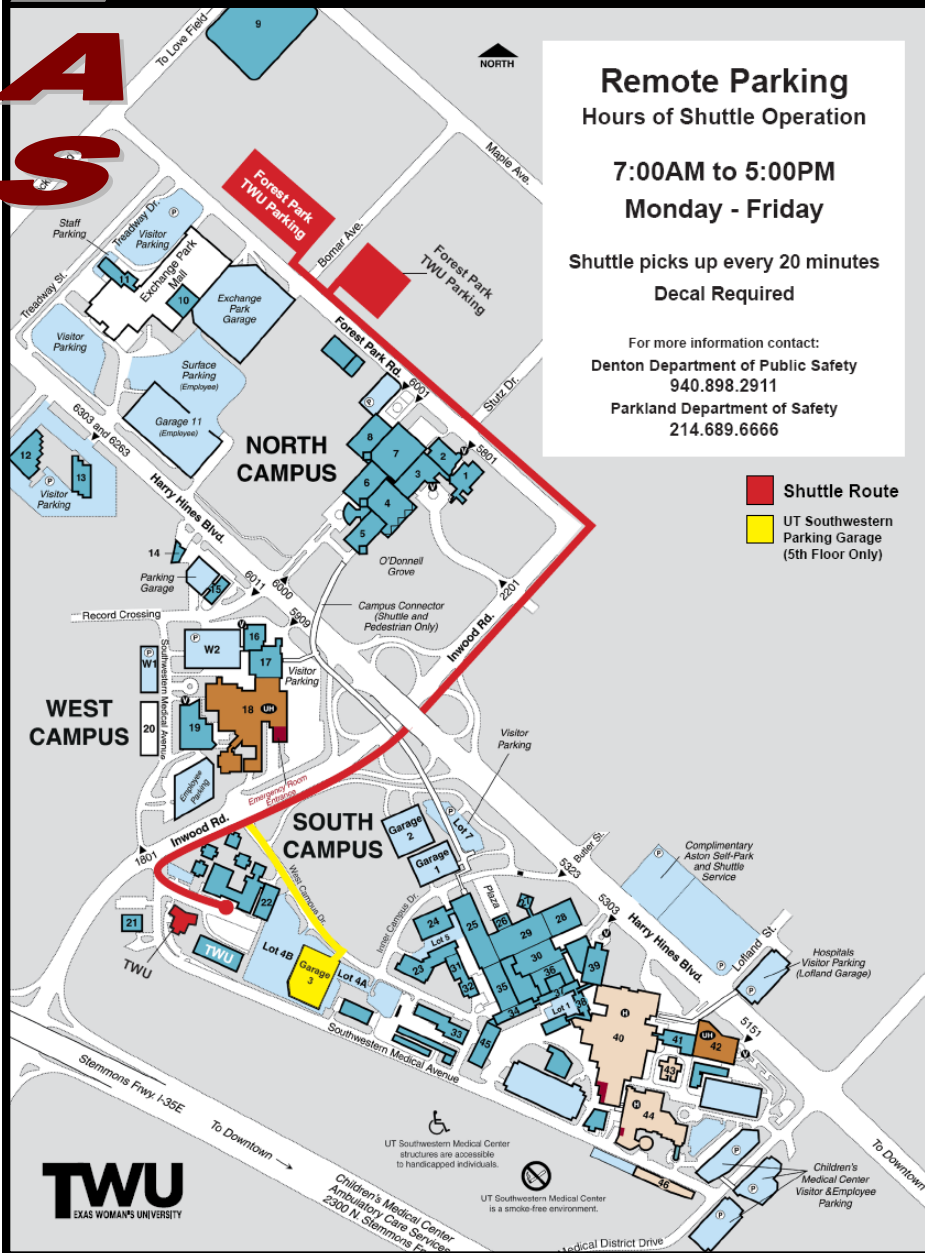

PARKING UPDATE!

Until the new parking garage is completed for the T. Boone Pickens Institute of Health Sciences-Dallas Center, 2 remote parking lots (see map above) have been made available, with shuttle service every 20 minutes.

The projected timeline for construction of the new garage is listed below:

Spring 2011	Abatement of the Education Building
Summer 2011	Demolition of the Education Building
Fall 2011	Construction of the Parking Garage

The goal is to have the garage available in Spring 2012.

COLLEGE ACCESS CHALLENGE GRANT

If you will be a junior or senior at the end of this semester AND you plan on taking 6 hours Summer 1 AND you are Pell grant eligible – you may receive \$2,000. Scholarships are being awarded right now!

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board has announced a new grant program to provide financial assistance to students with financial need who have completed 60 hours towards a degree. Qualifying students are eligible to receive a \$2,000 grant if they enroll in at least 6 hours in one summer 2011 semester at an approved institution of higher education. Priority will be given to students who enroll in 6 hours in the first summer term (11/SU1) and to students pursuing degrees in Physical Science, Computer Science, Engineering, or Mathematics.

Eligible recipients must meet the following requirements:

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Texas resident
- Classified as a Junior or Senior (completed 60 hours) by the end of the spring term
- Pell Grant eligible with an EFC less than \$5273
- Enroll in at least 6 hours in a summer 2011 semester

Submit an electronic application to the Coordinating Board by 5 p.m. April 30, 2011, and complete the 2011/12 FAFSA by April 30, 2011.
