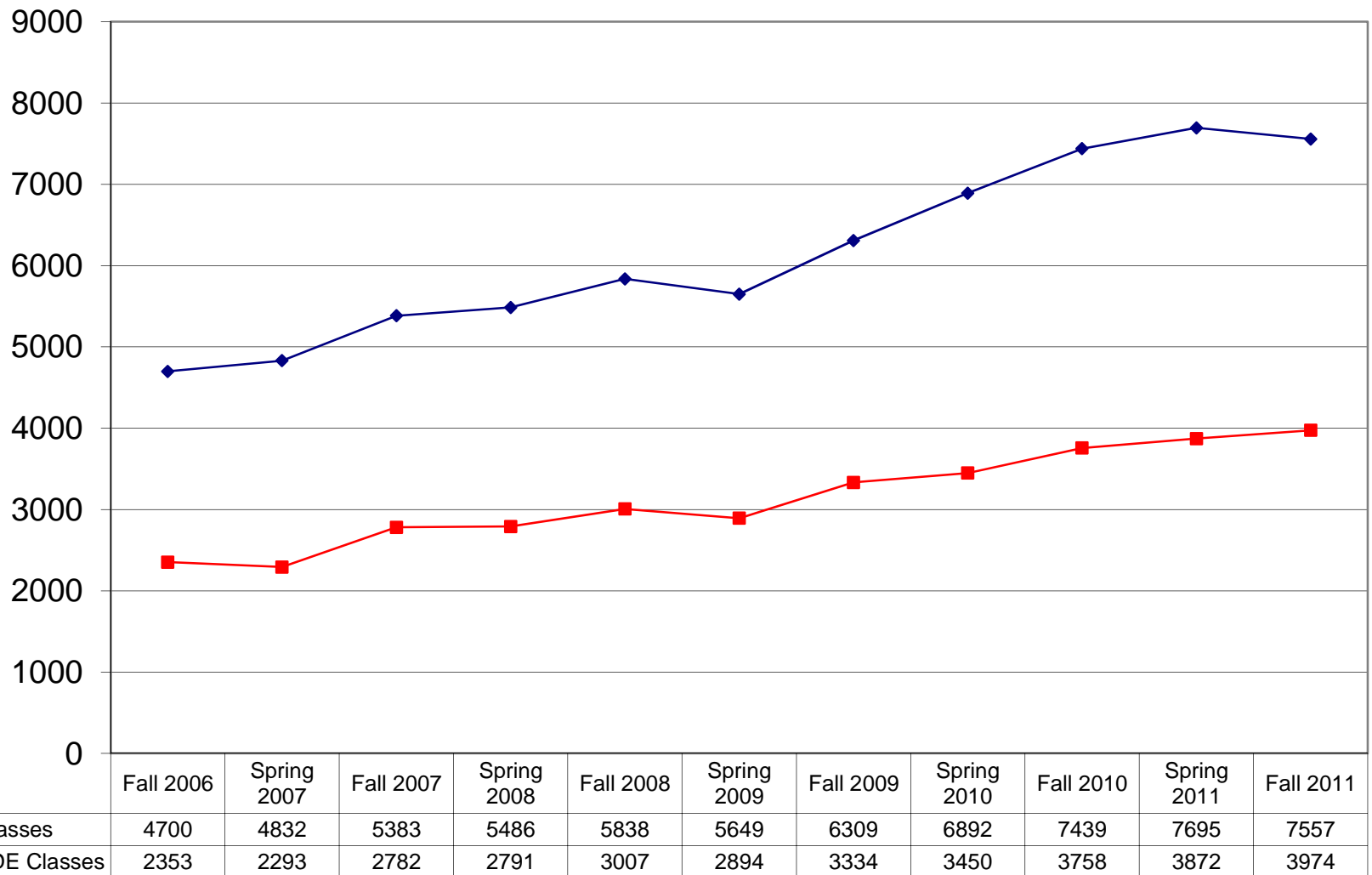

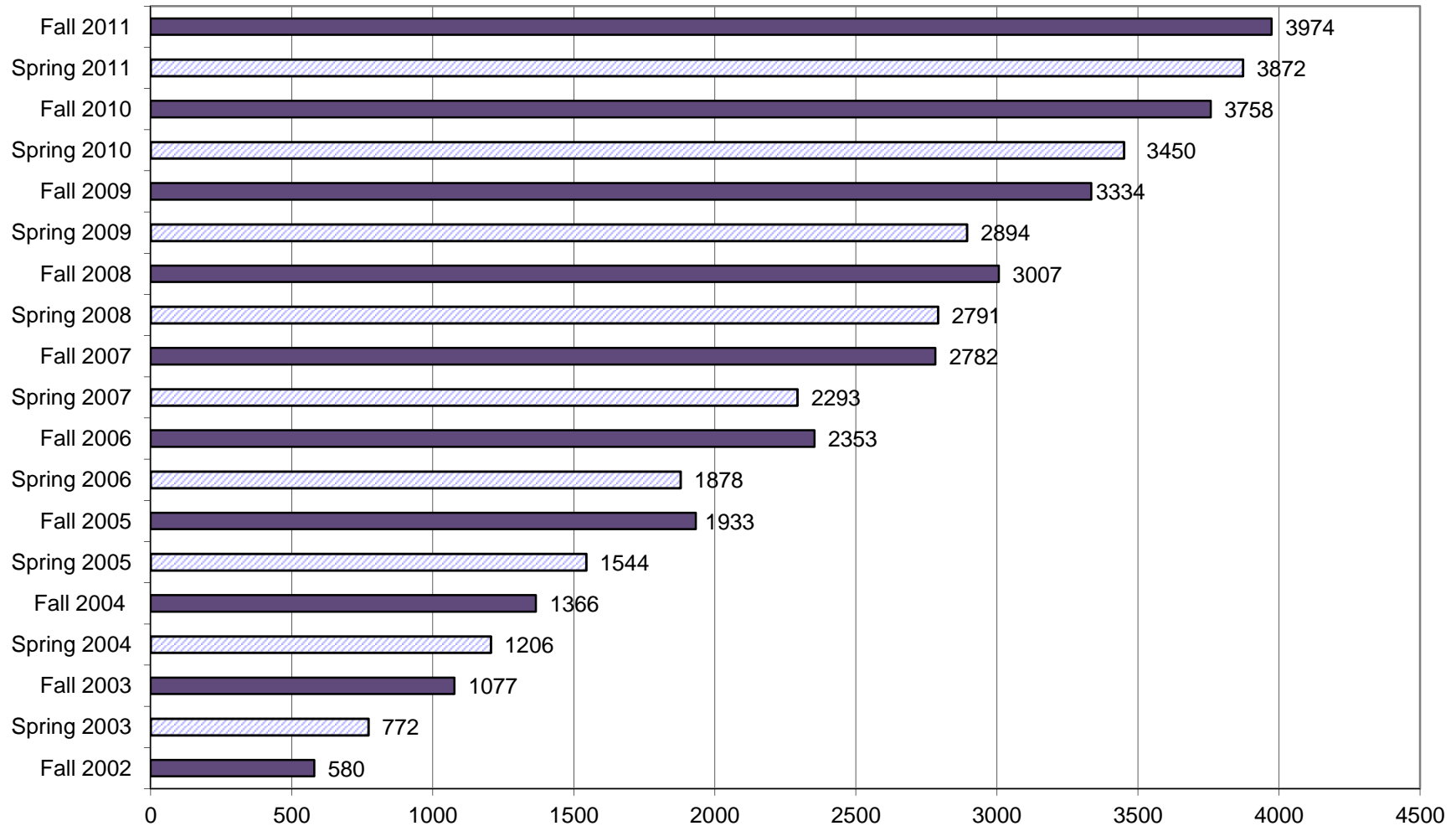

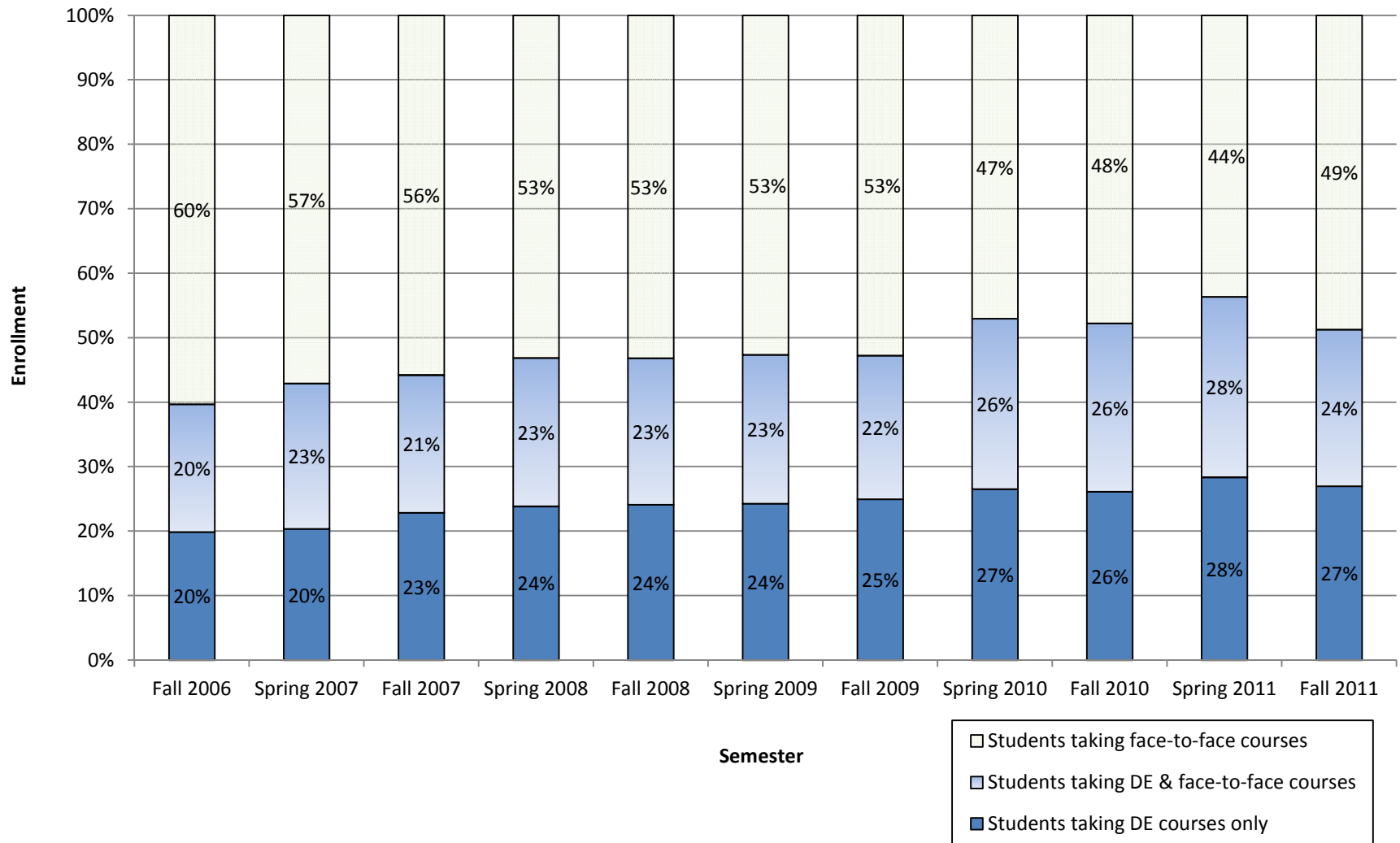
Texas Woman's University Distance Education Growth



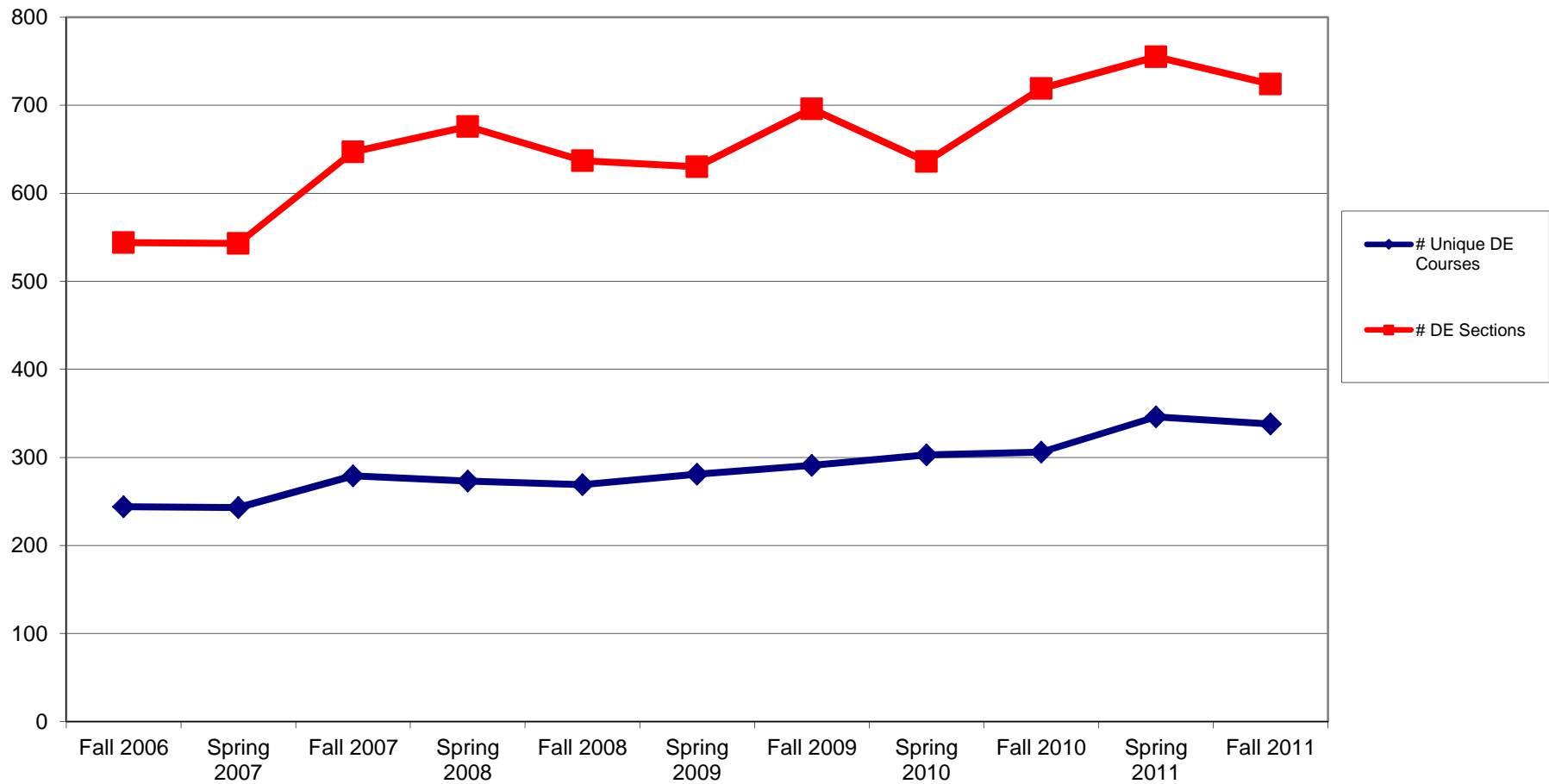
Students Taking Distance Education Classes Only



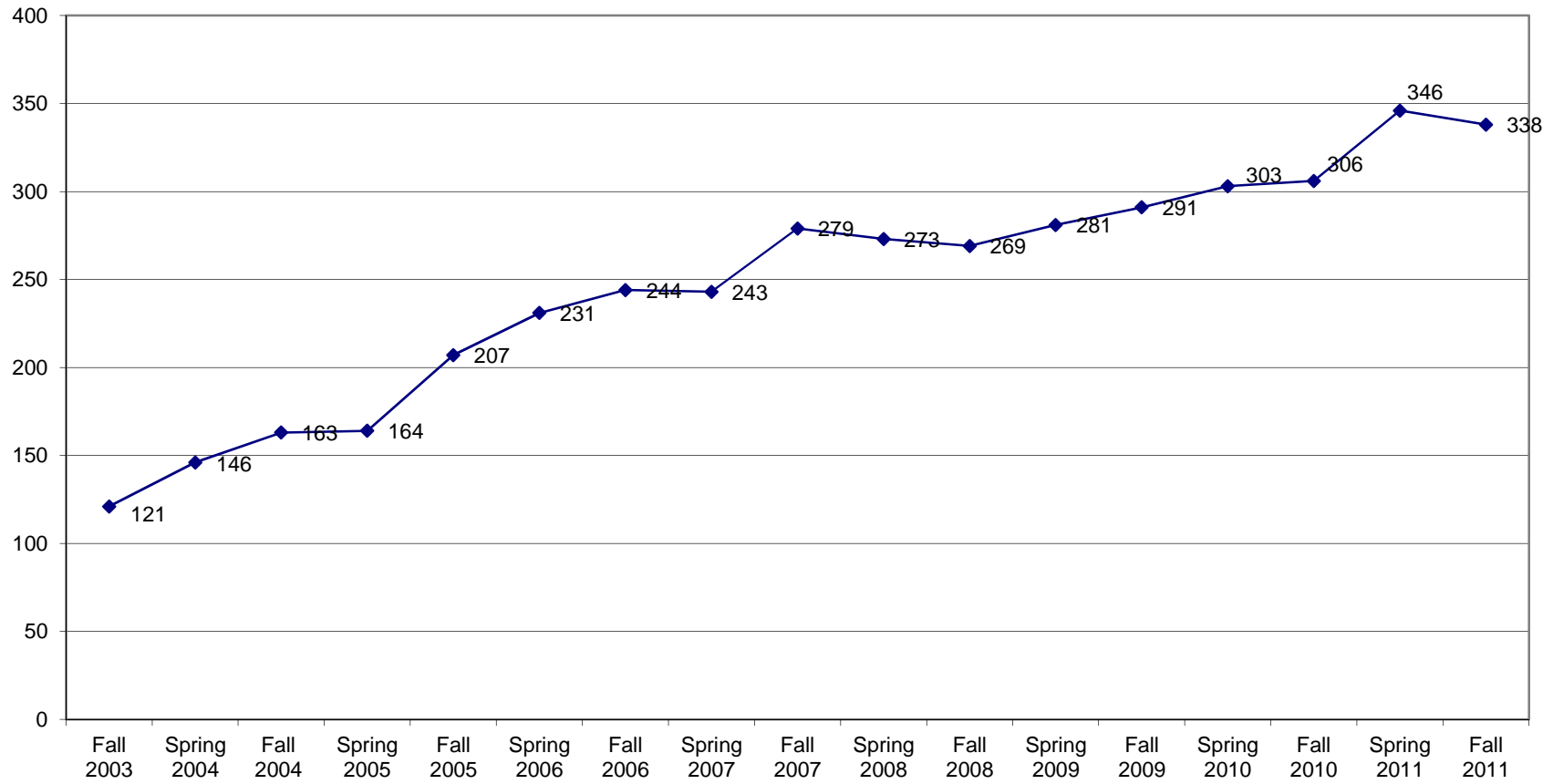
Distance Education as Percent of Total Enrollment



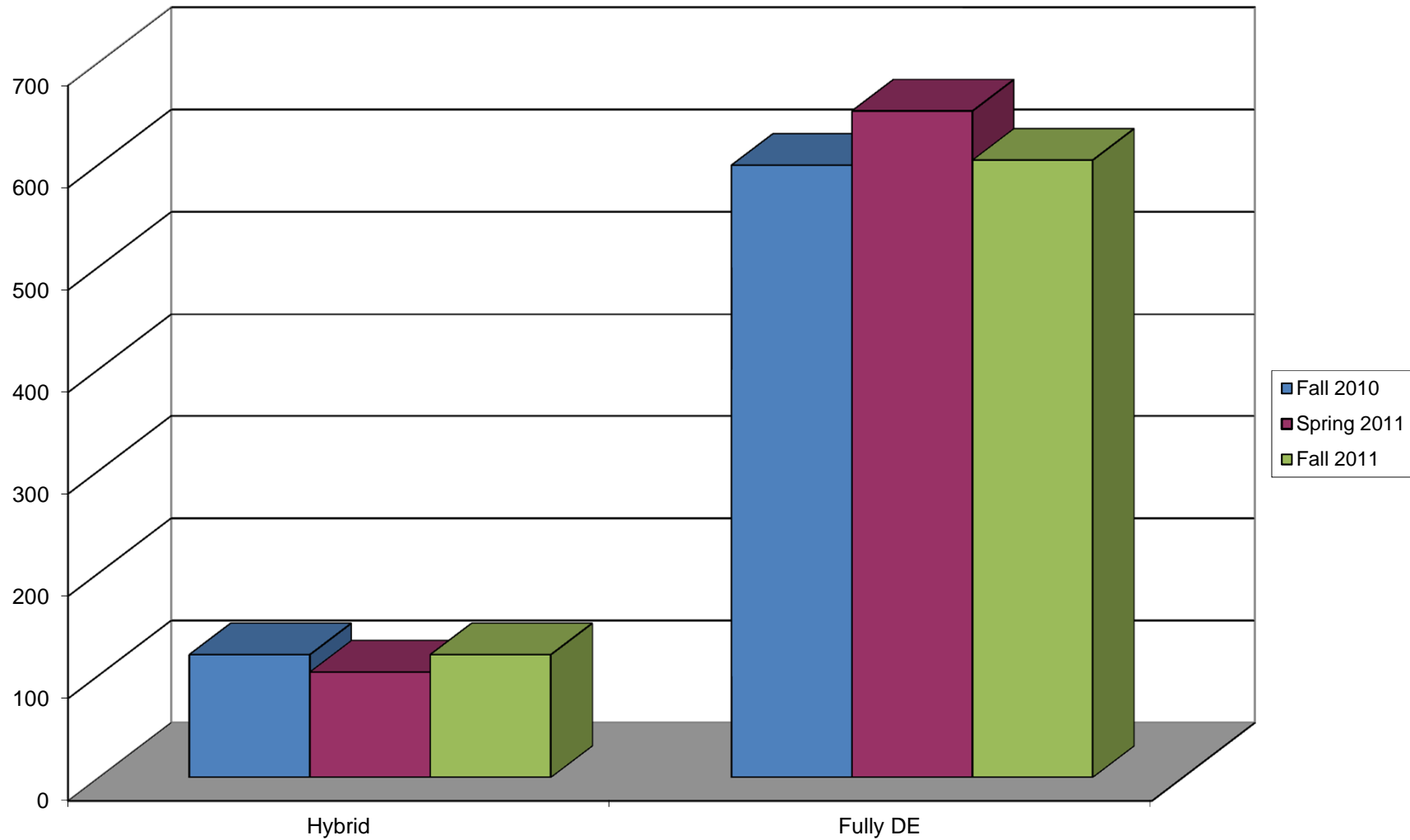
Distance Education Courses and Sections



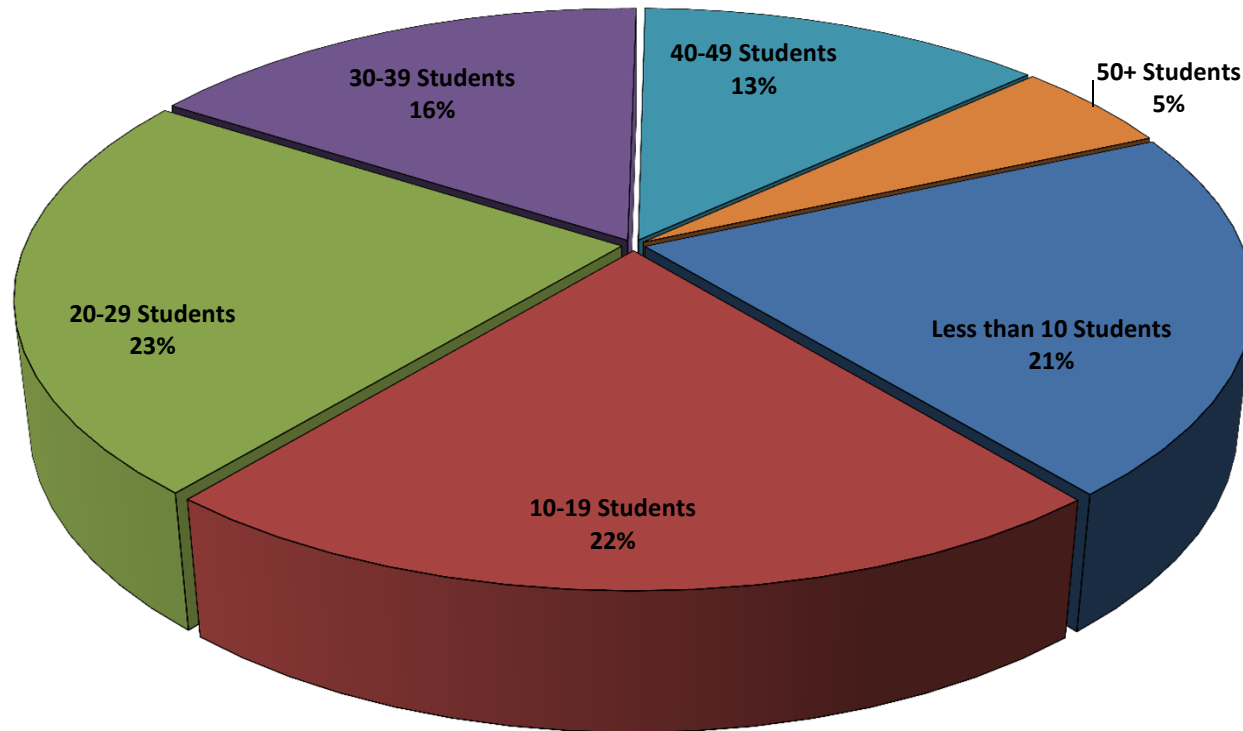
Number of Unique Distance Education Courses at TWU



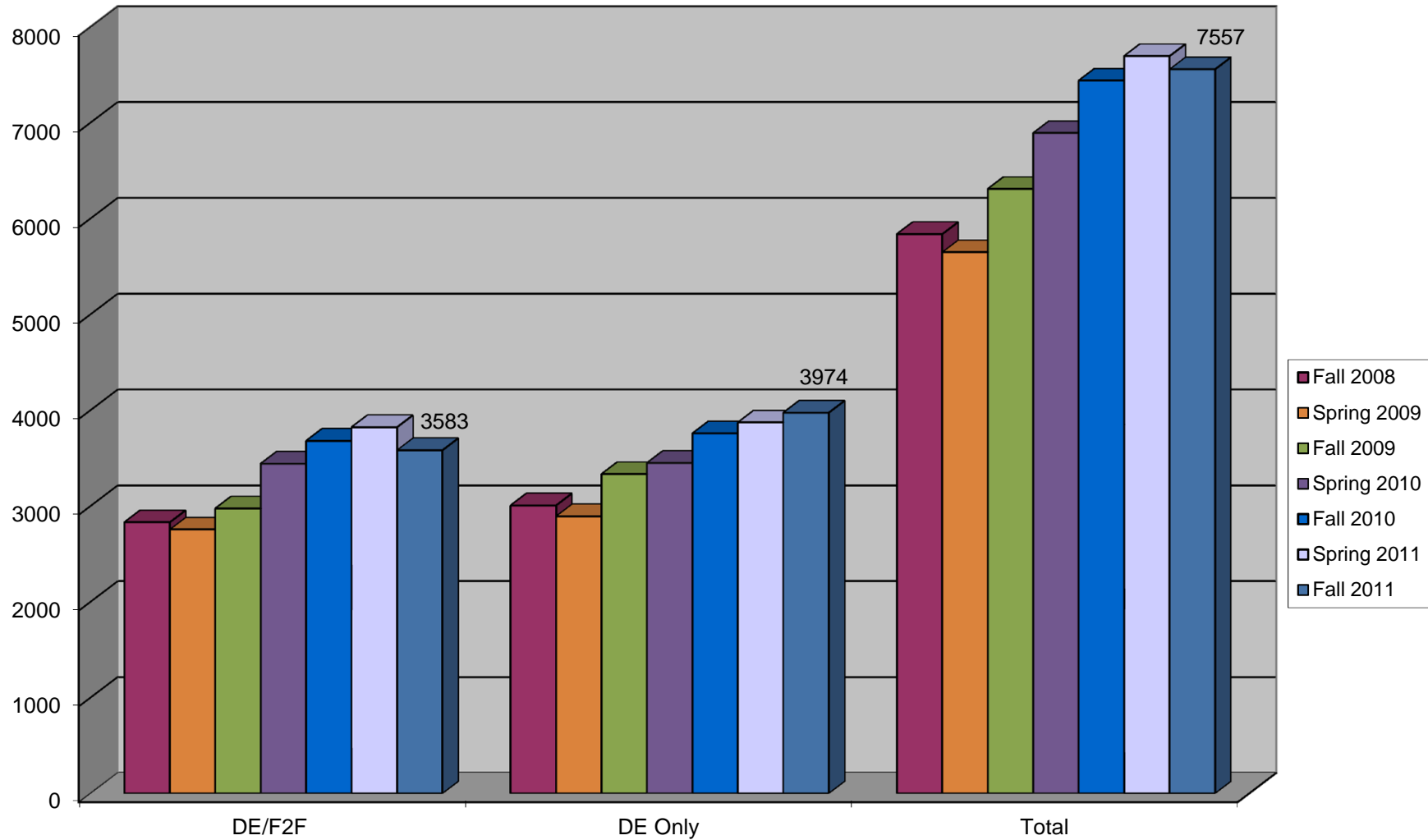
Distance Education Sections by THECB Classifications

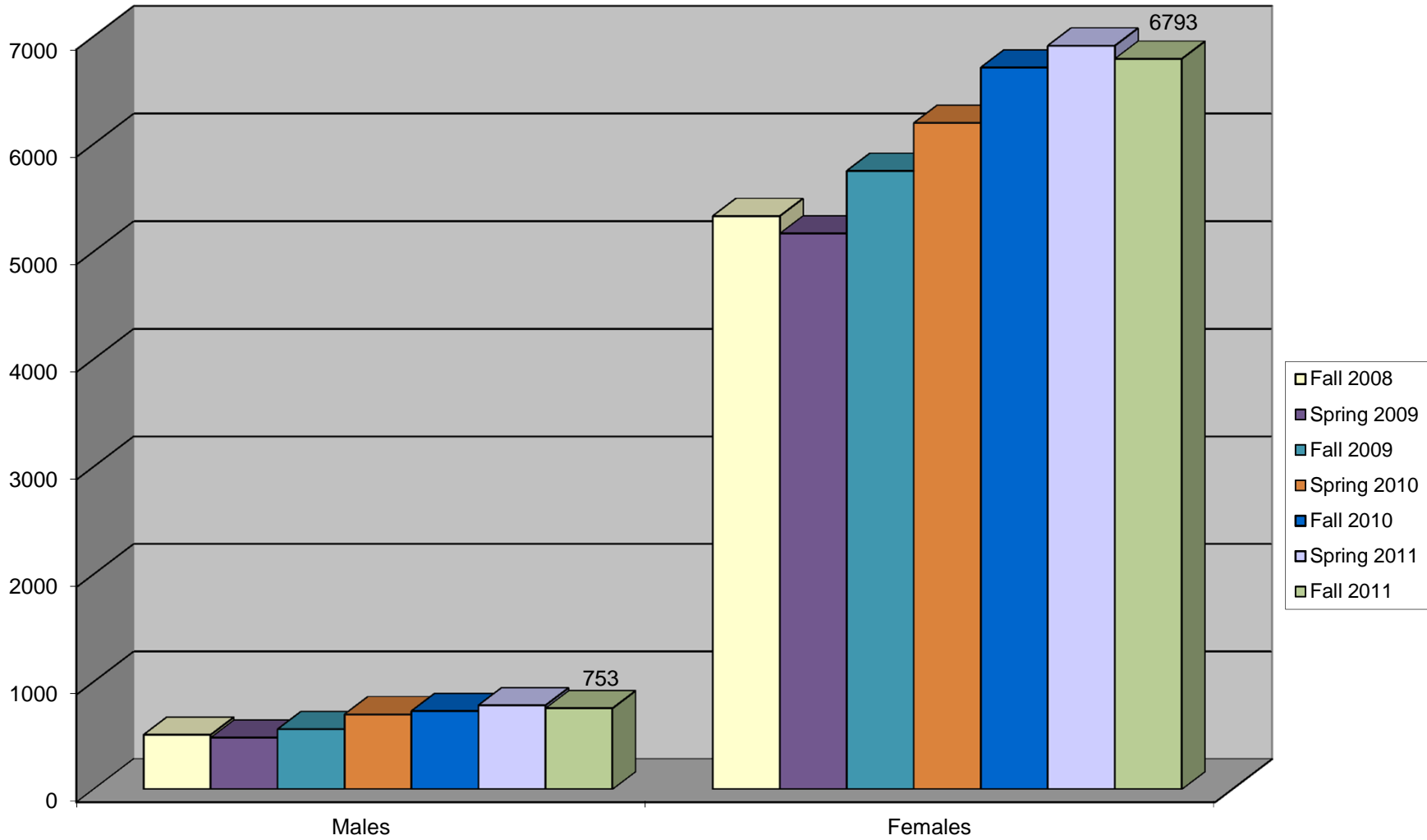


Distance Education Enrollment by Instructional Method

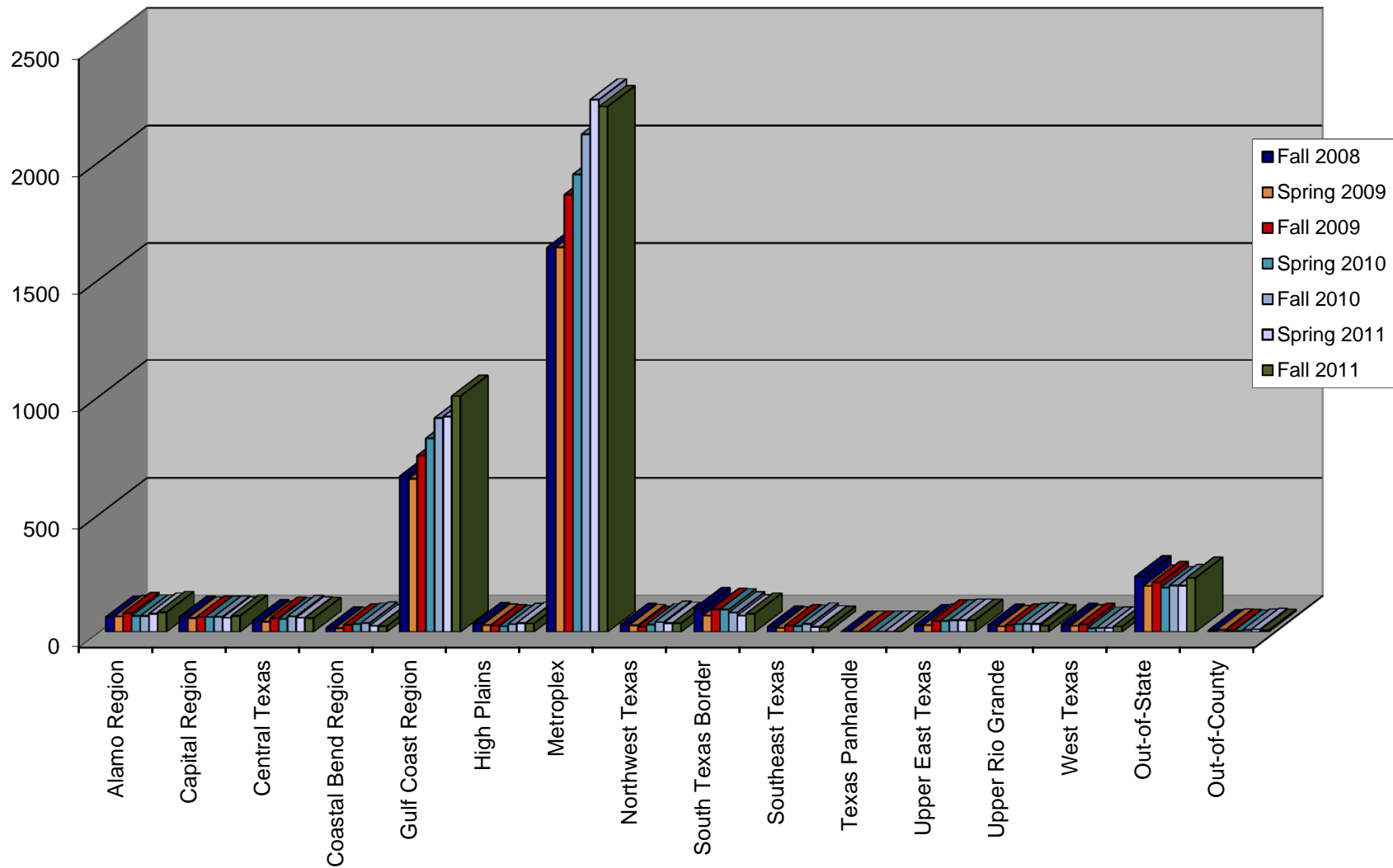

Distance Education Enrollment by Gender

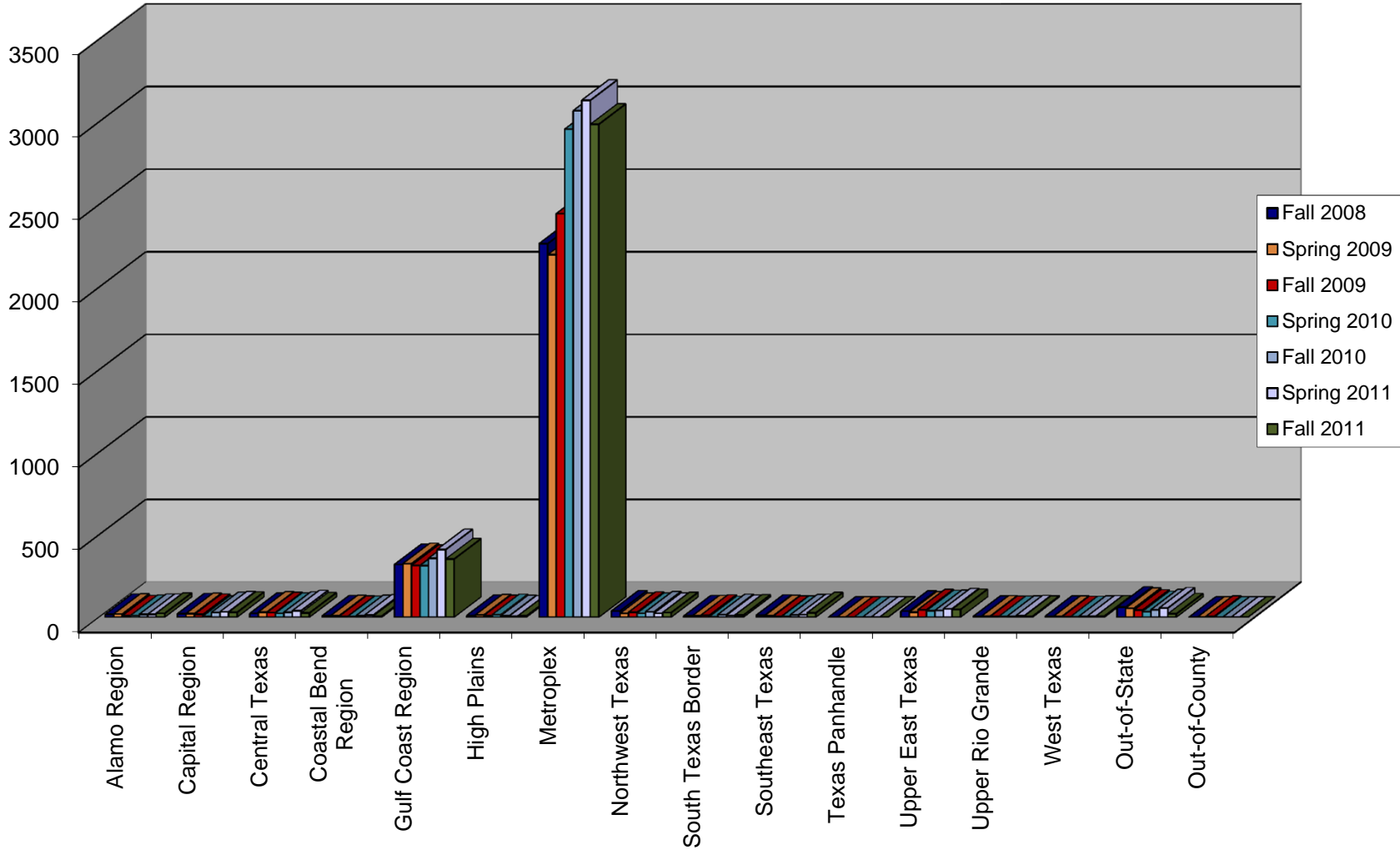


Student Enrollment by Region Distance Education Only Students

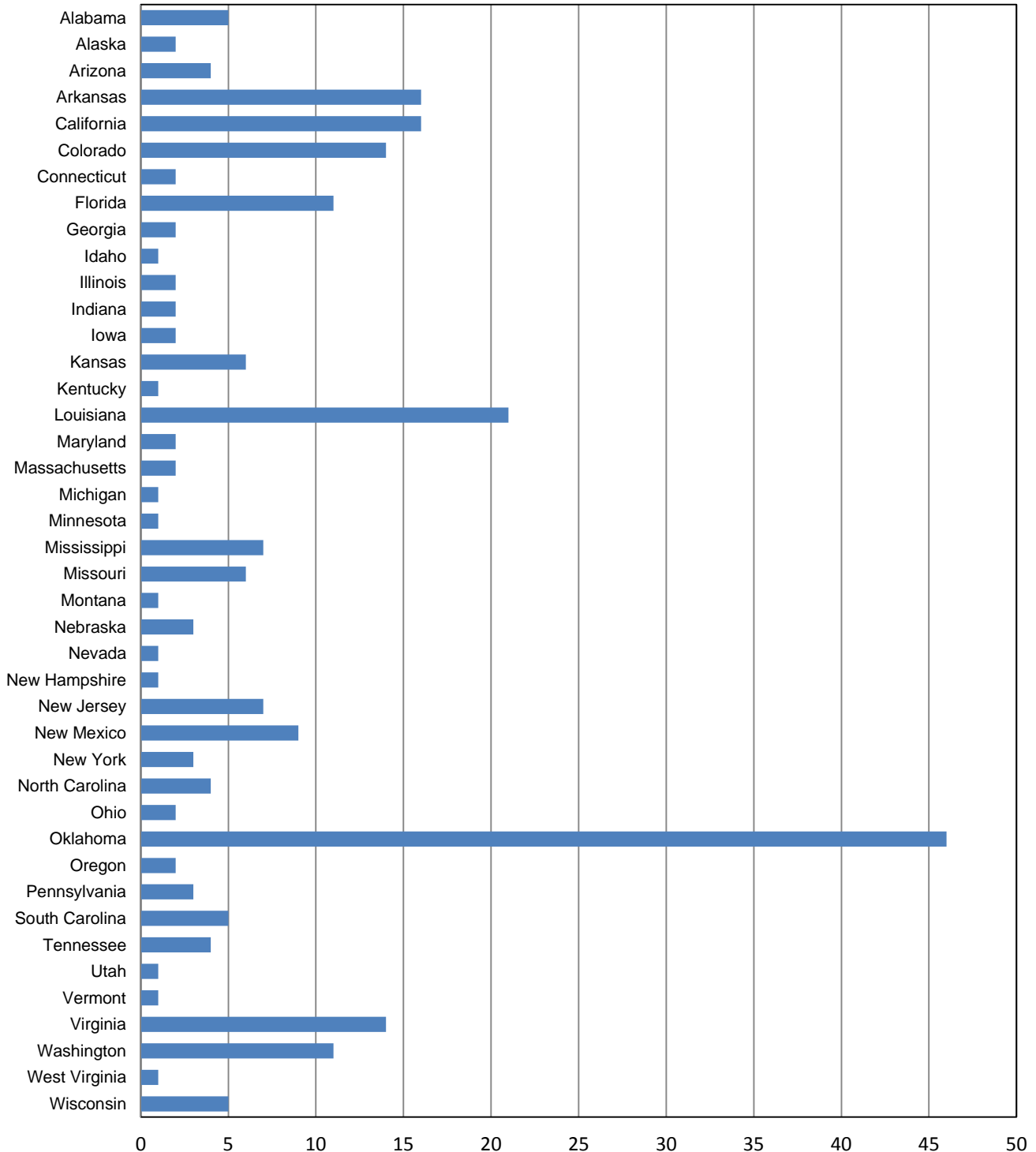

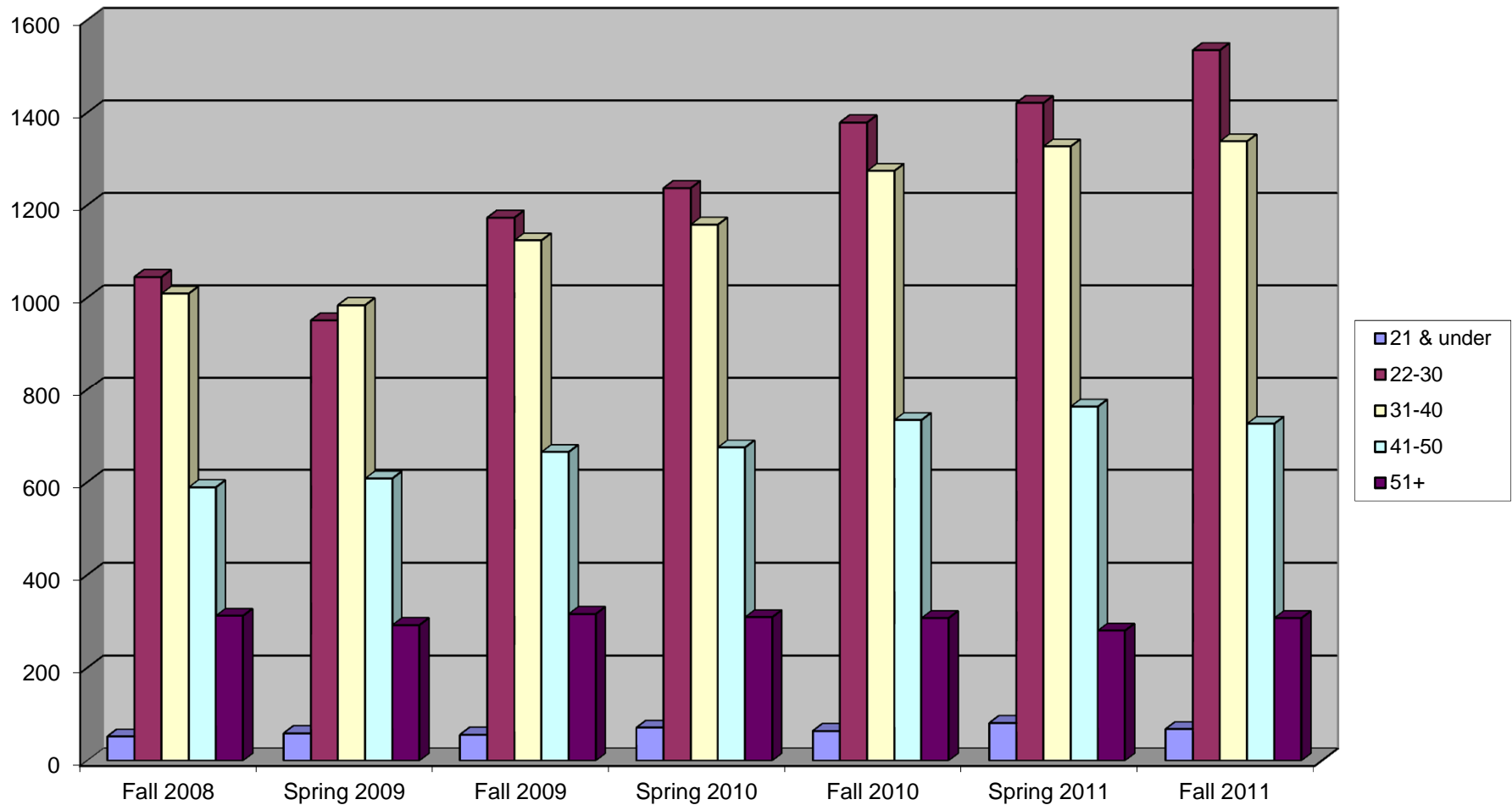

Location of Out-of-State Students Taking DE Courses N=250

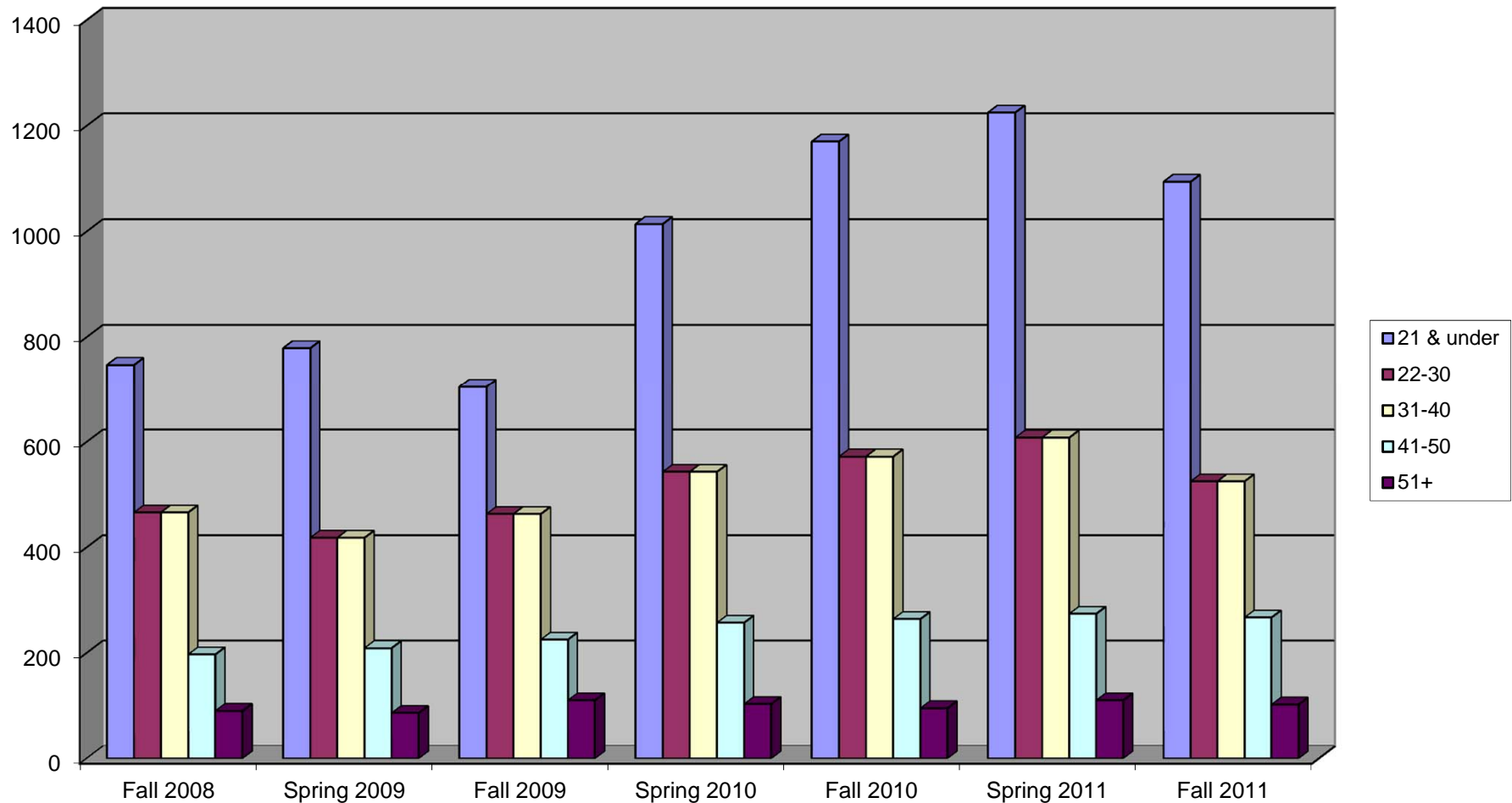


Student Enrollment by Age Range Distance Education Only Students



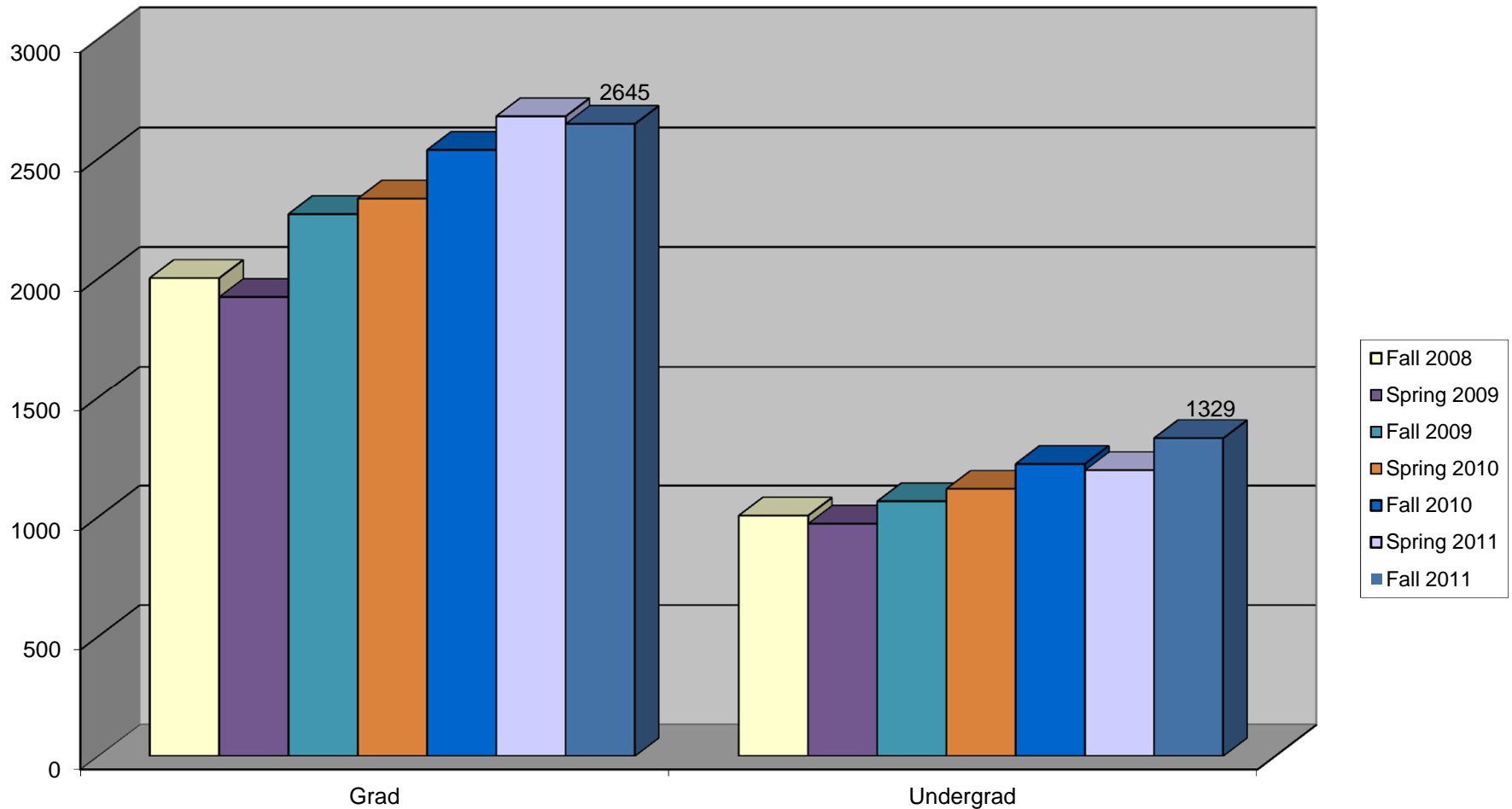

Student Enrollment by Age Range Distance Education/Face-to-Face Students

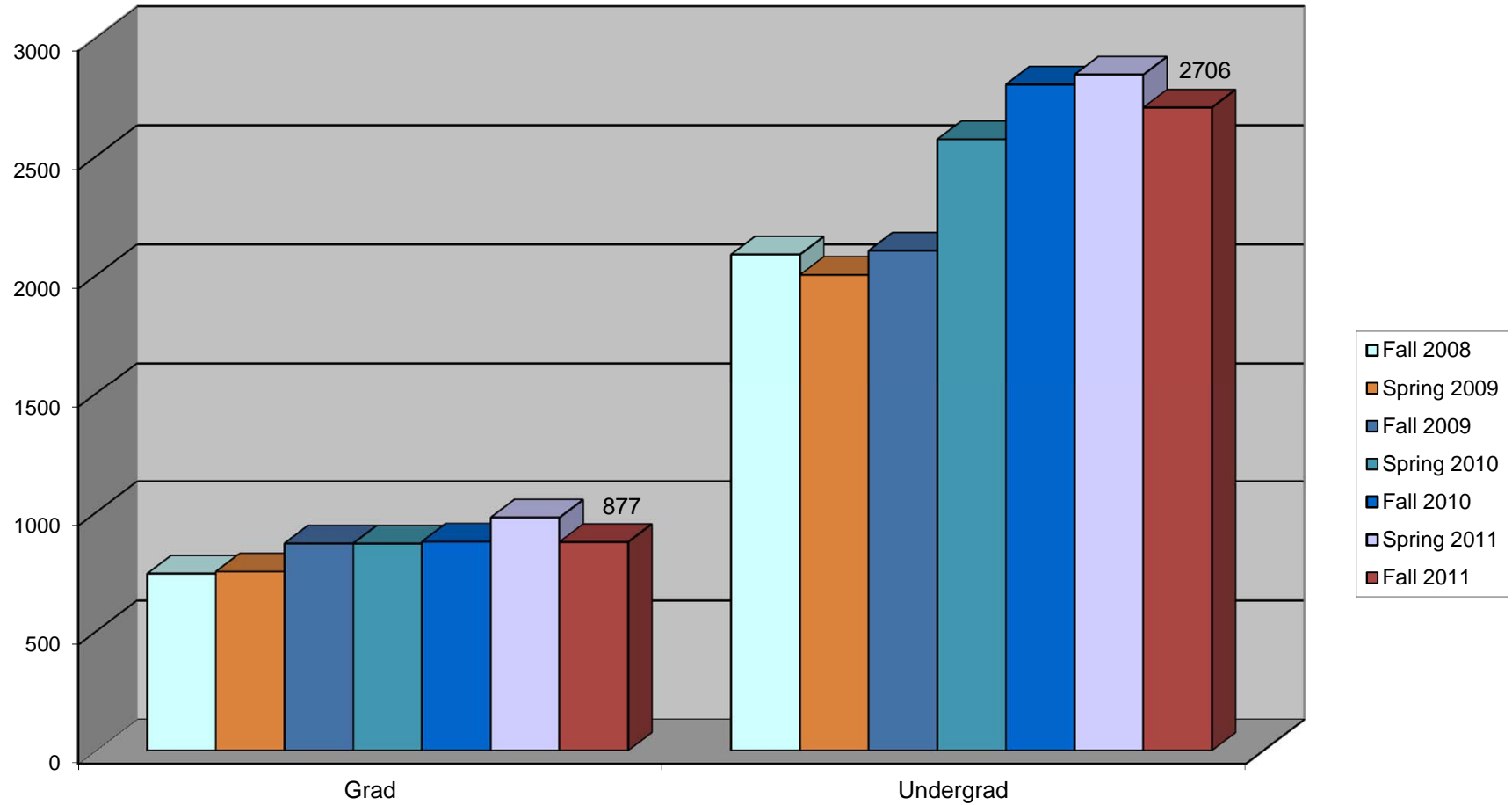

Student Enrollment by Academic Level Distance Education Only Students

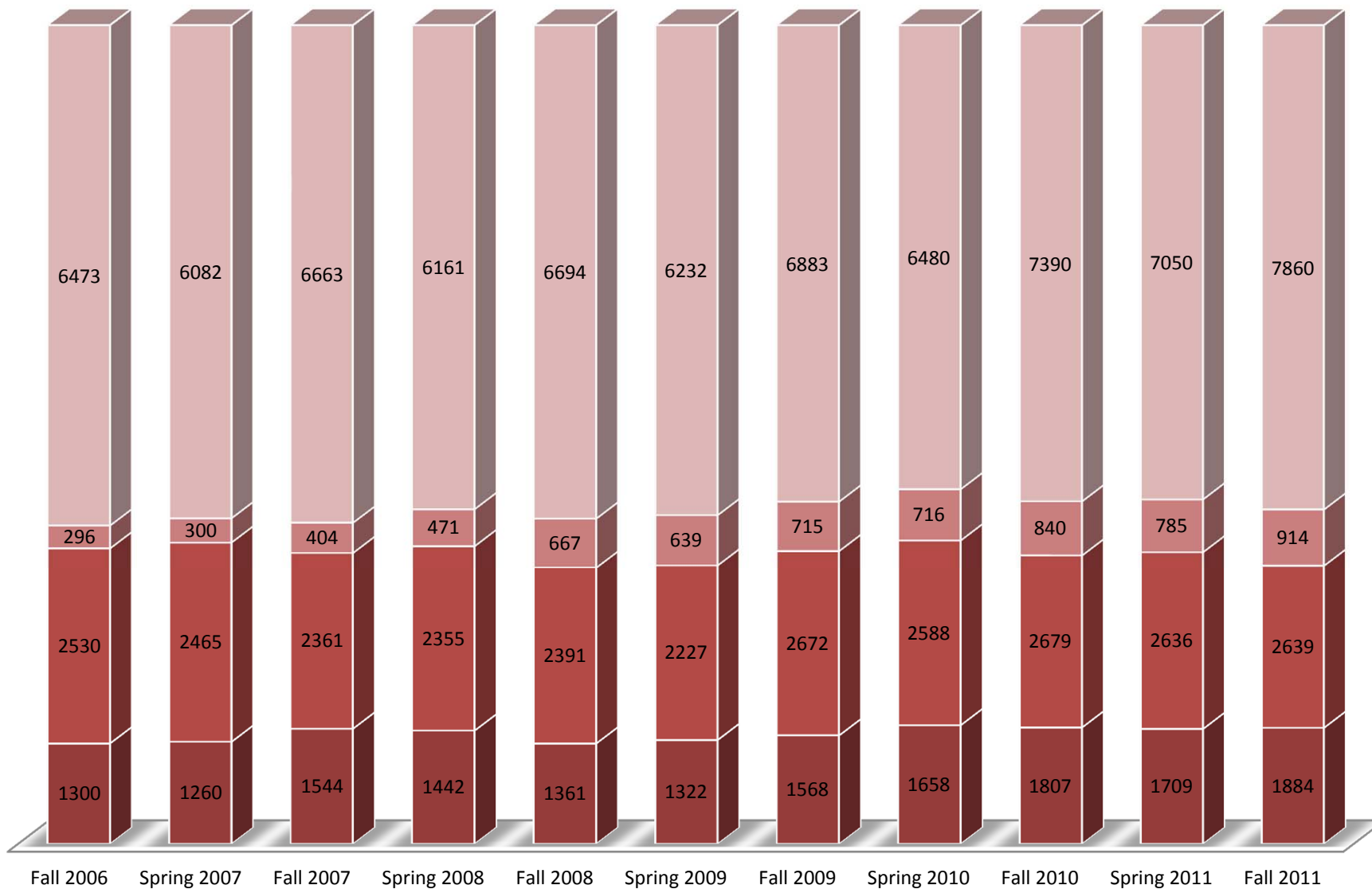


Student Enrollment by Academic Level Distance Education/Face-to-Face Students



TWU FTE Composition

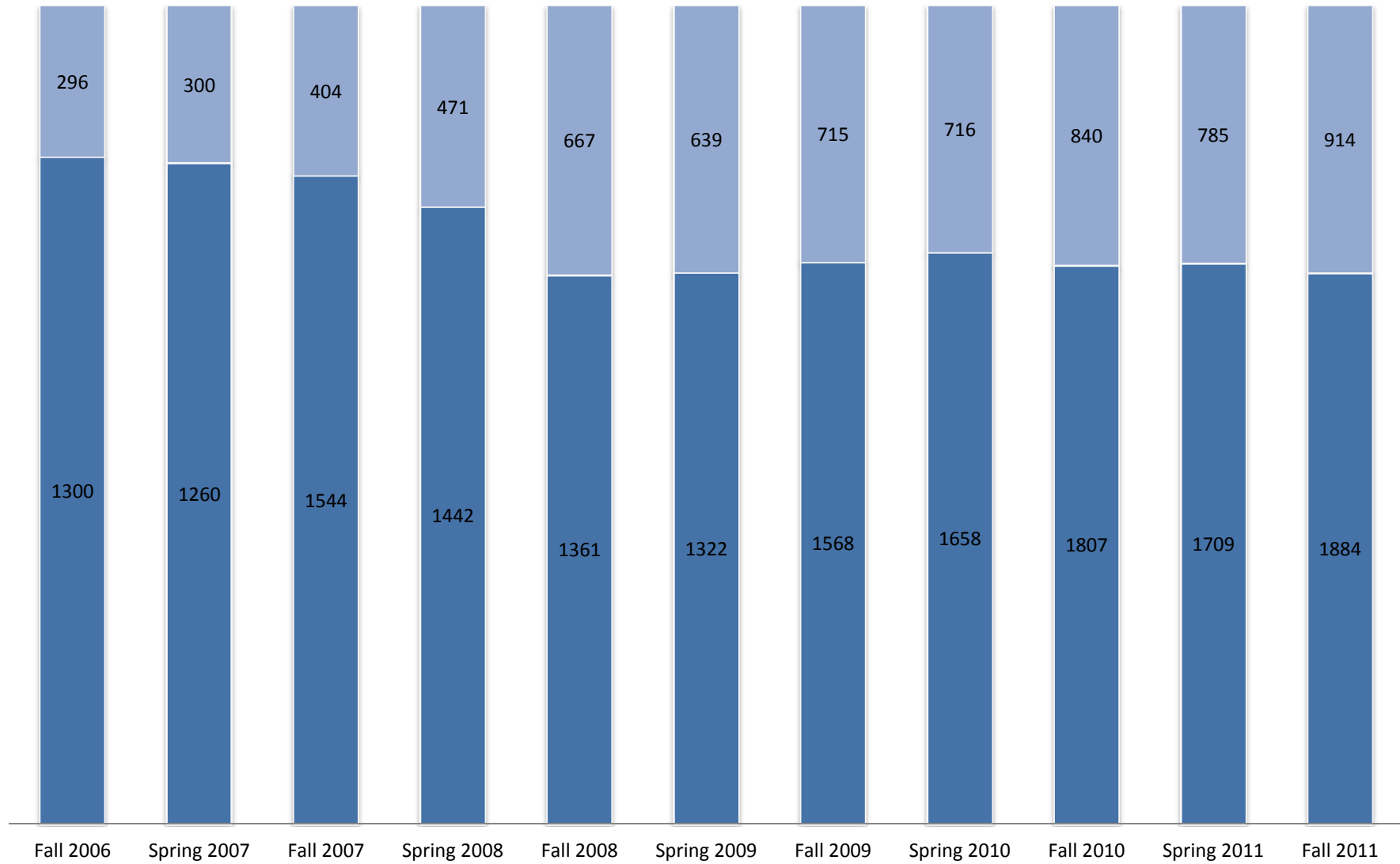
■ DE Only Grad FTE

Students Taking Only DE Courses

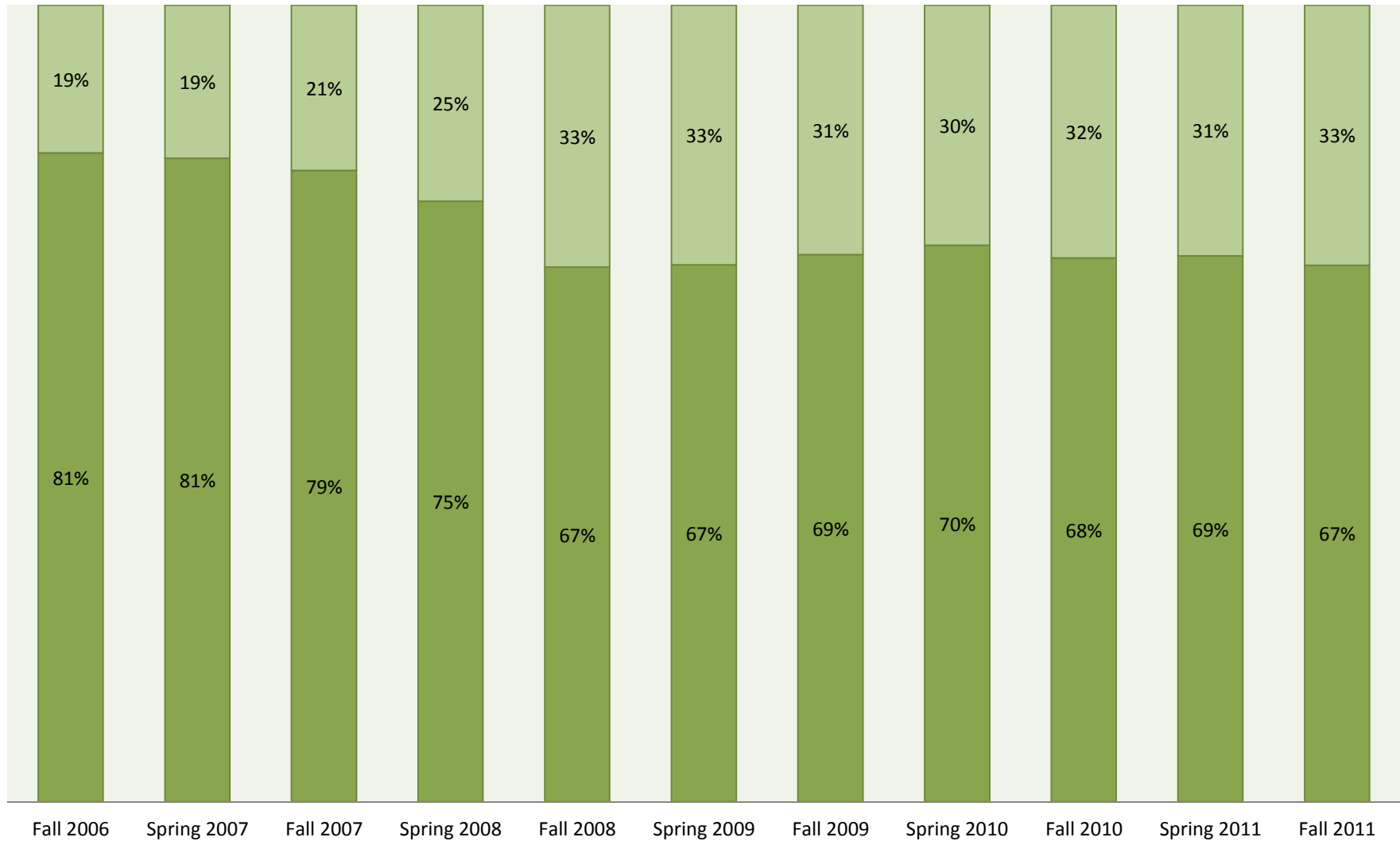

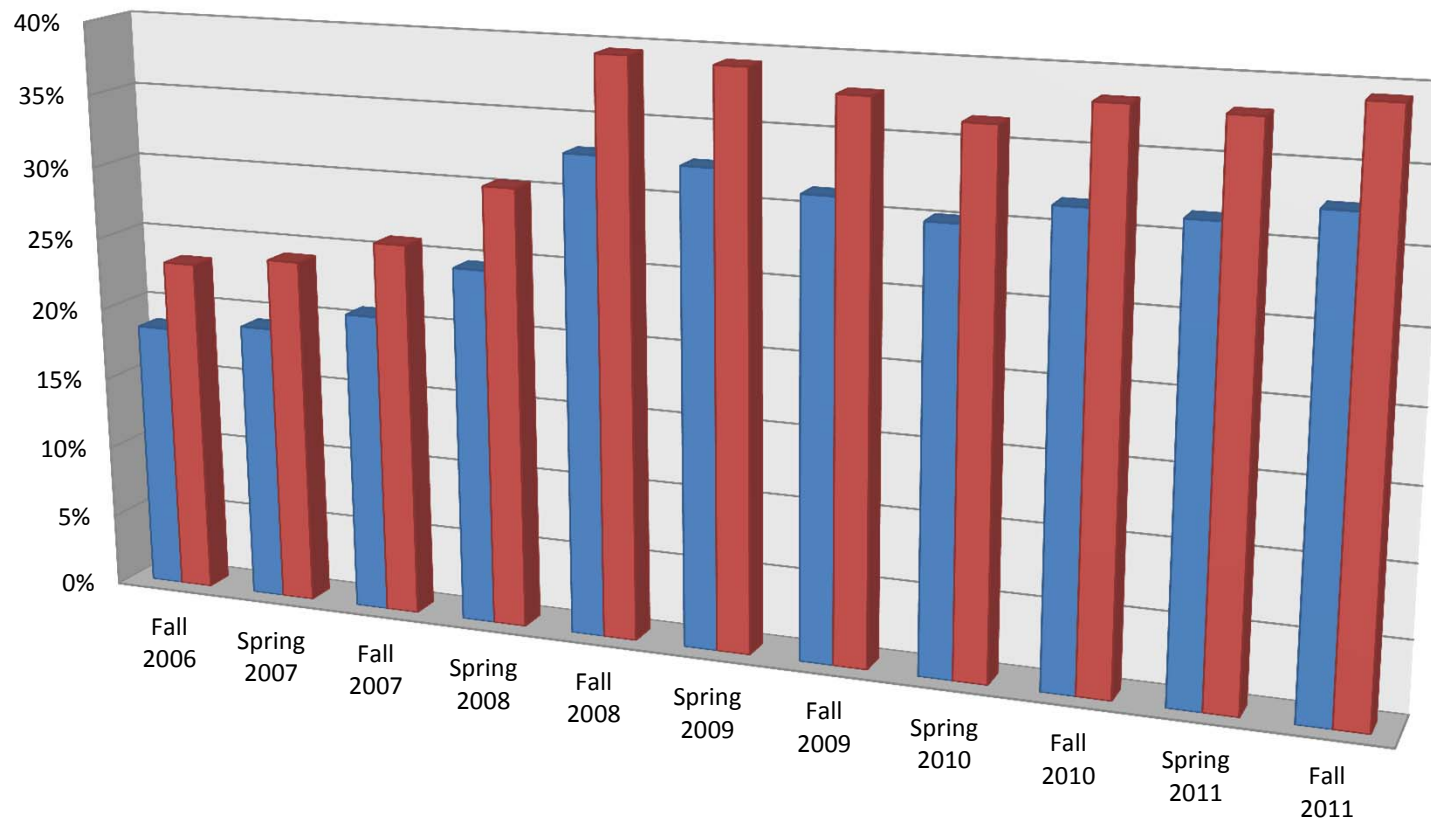
TWU Distance Education % FTE Grad/Undergrad Ratio by Year

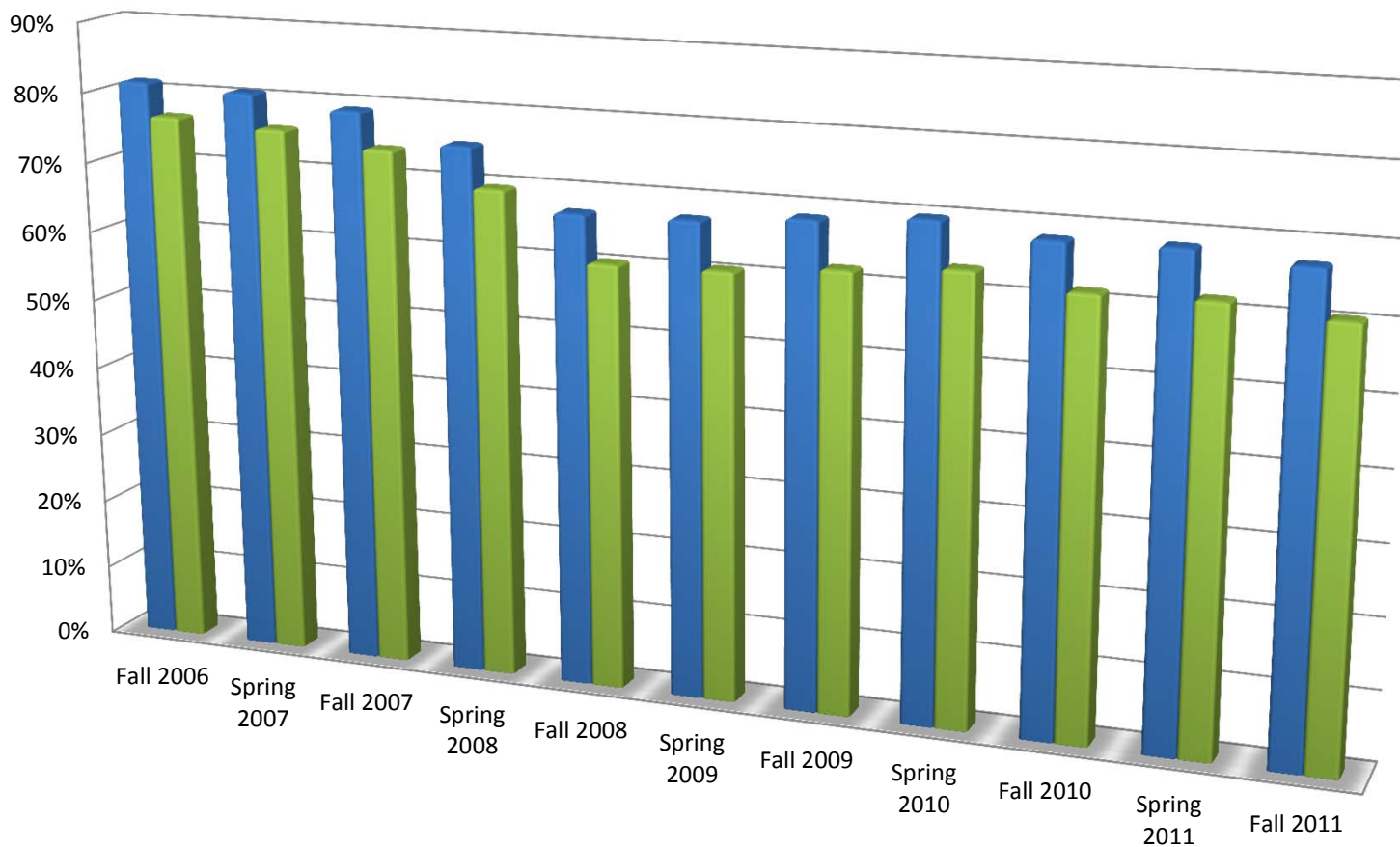


Percentage of Distance Education FTE & SCH Generated by Undergraduate Students by Semester *Students Taking Only DE Courses*

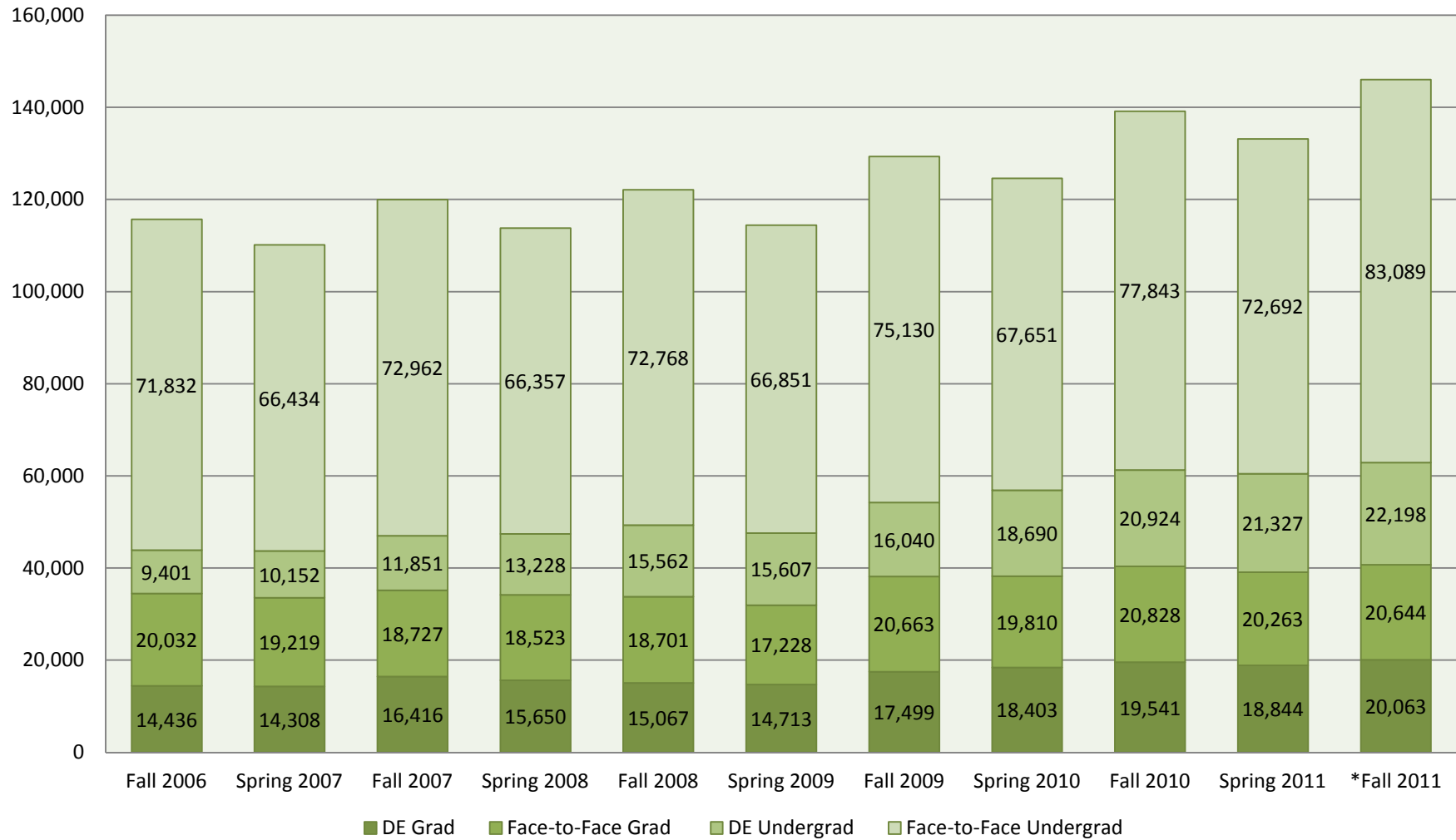
Percentage of Distance Education FTE & SCH Generated by Graduate Students by Semester *Students Taking Only DE Courses*



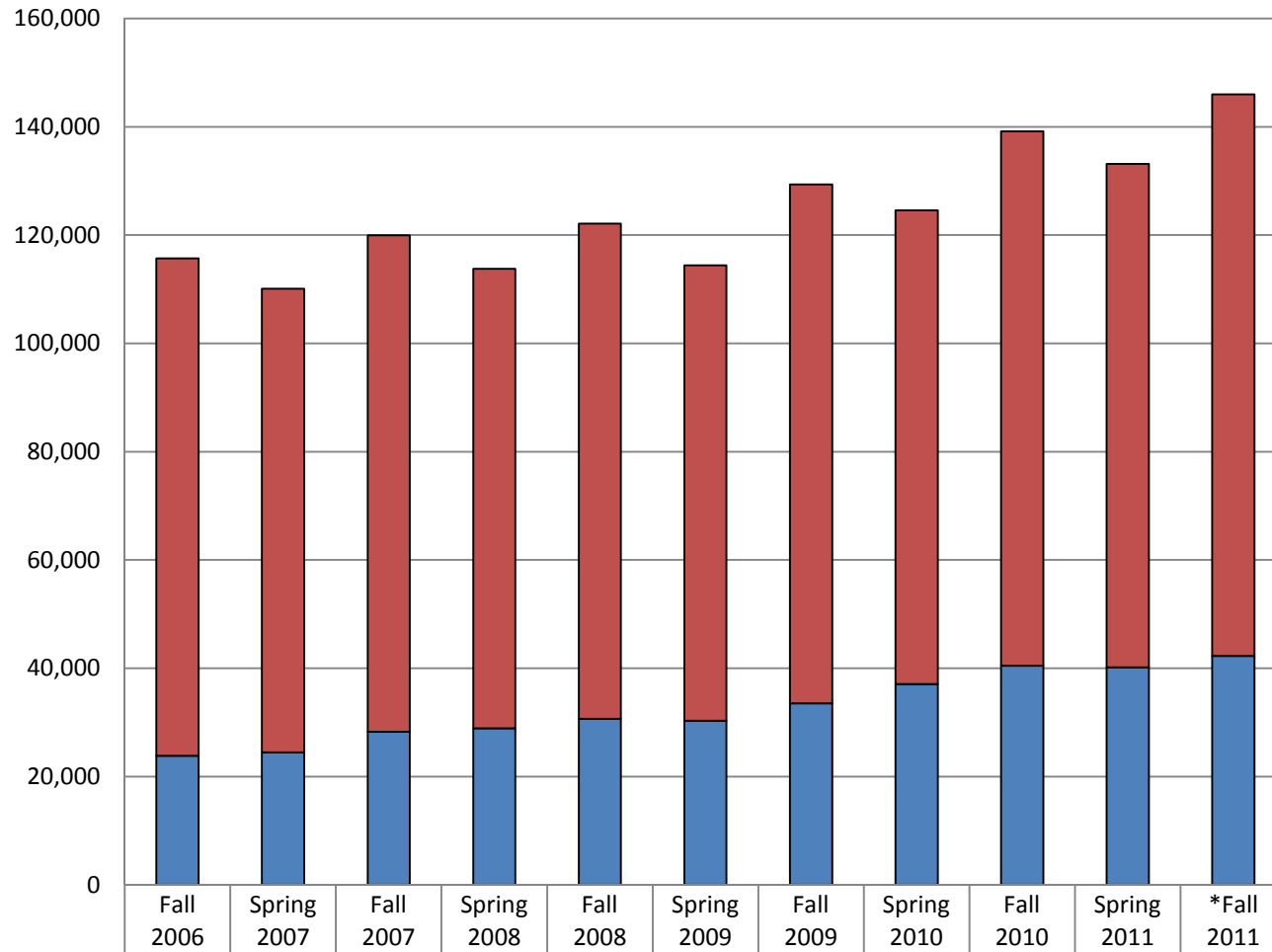

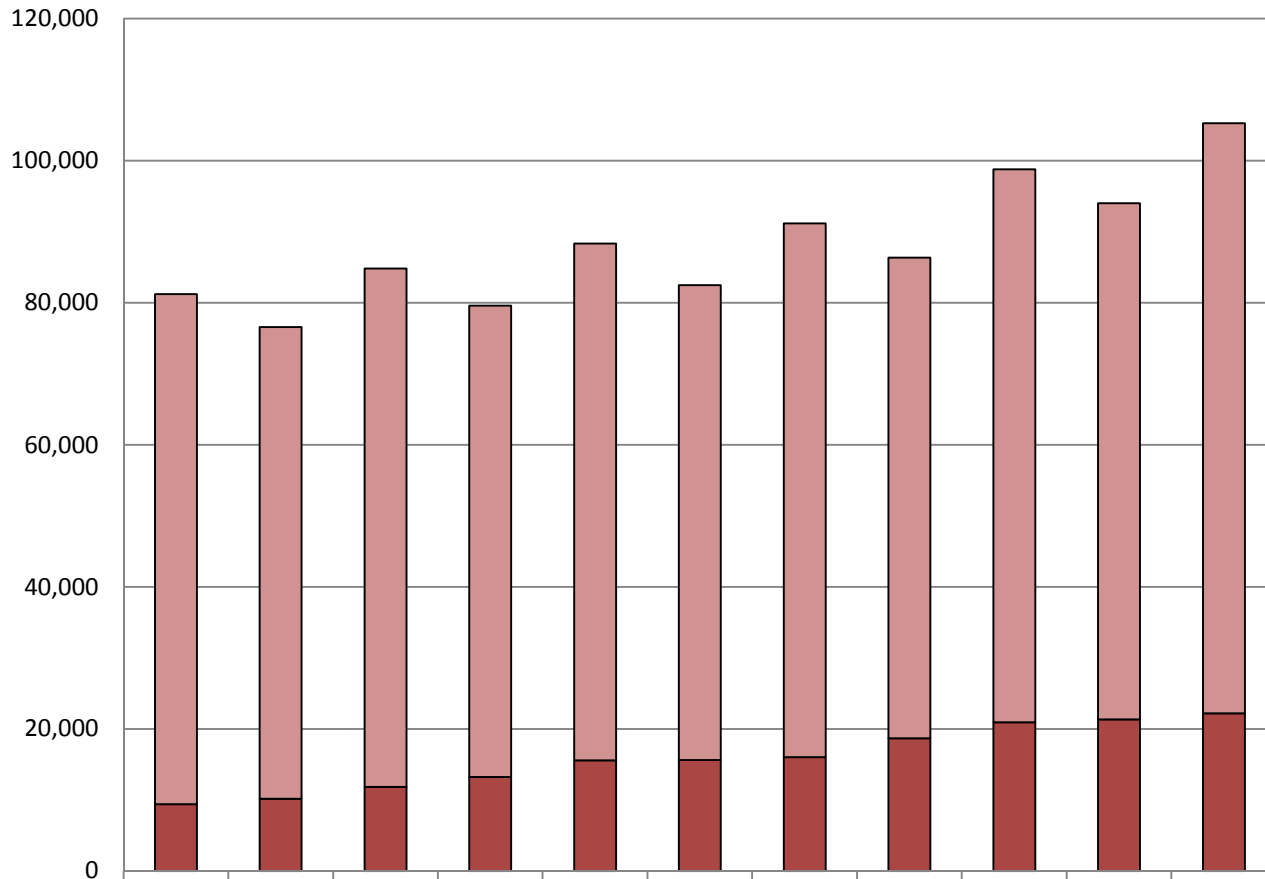

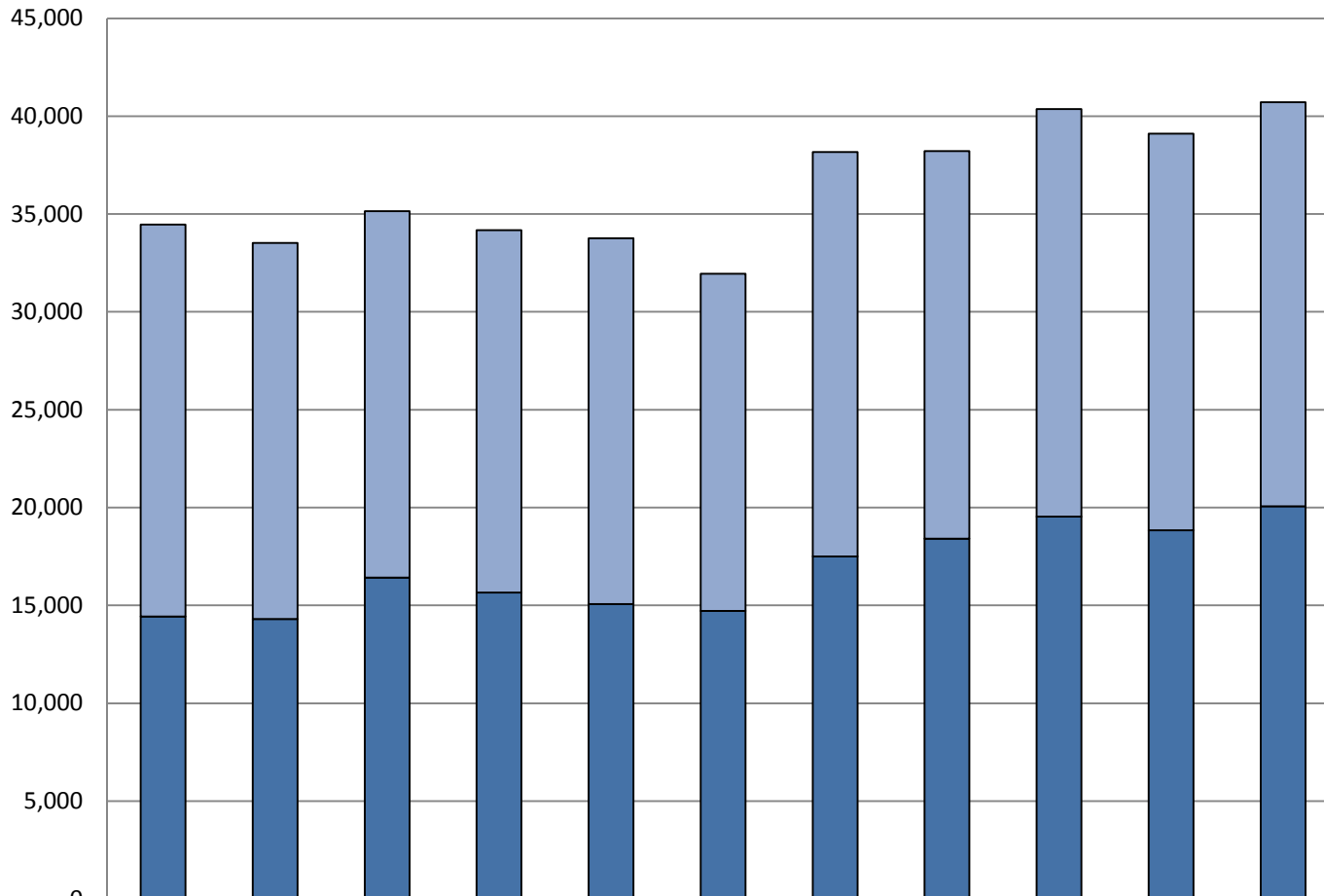
