3. Sign and submit this form to the TWU College of Professional Education (Keep a copy for your records.)
4. Have a cumulative college GPA of at least 3.25 or score above the 75<sup>th</sup> percentile on one of the following college admissions test(s) - ACT, SAT or GRE).
5. Be enrolled in coursework that is necessary to begin a career in teaching or plan to complete such coursework. Coursework that will prepare a student to teach in a high-need subject area (e.g., math courses for a student who intends to be a math teacher) is acceptable.
6. Be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or permanent resident.
7. Not have defaulted on or owe a refund to any previous student aid program.
8. Award will be prorated each semester based on enrollment status if less than full-time.
9. Maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined by the TWU Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress policy. These requirements are available on the TWU Student Financial Aid web site at [www.twu.edu/finaid](http://www.twu.edu/finaid).
