



Announcing the Helen DeVitt Jones Scholarships in English

The Department of English at Texas Tech University is pleased to announce the Helen DeVitt Jones Scholarships in English, to be awarded to incoming graduate students in Fall 2010. In total, we will award \$95,000 in scholarship money to students who apply by January 15, 2010 and begin graduate study in Fall 2010. Scholarships may be awarded to students in any area of literary study, any genre of creative writing, or linguistics. All applicants to the M.A. program and Ph.D. program are eligible for these prizes. Our intent is to promote excellence across all fields of study.

Jones Scholars will receive total award amounts of at least \$22,000 for Ph.D. students and \$20,000 for M.A. students, including an appointment as a teaching or research assistant and a Jones Scholarship in the range of \$5,000 to \$11,000 for the 2010-2011 academic year. After the first year of study, Jones Scholars will continue to receive assistantship support (one additional year for M.A. recipients, four additional years for Ph.D. recipients) and will become eligible for the full range of scholarships provided by the Department of English and the Graduate School.

We expect to name at least 10 Jones Scholars for the 2010-2011 academic year.
