Practicum is a course designed to allow the faculty of a component to evaluate how each student (majoring in either Child Development or Family Studies) has incorporated their studies to a work place situation. The Faculty remains in direct contact with the student and the site that the student chooses to complete their practicum hours.

Practicum Orientation Information

Pre-requisites:

- ✦ Students must be in last two semesters of degree plan
- ✦ Students must attend the mandatory orientation meeting held in October (for Spring practicum) or March (for Summer/Fall practicum). Meeting dates are posted on the Family Science website.
- ✦ Students must submit application on or before the listed deadline, including a signature from academic advisor verifying eligibility for graduation and reviewing sites chosen by students.
- ✦ Students must not be on academic probation.
