

Restricted Enrollment Family Therapy Clinical Courses

The following Family Therapy courses have restricted enrollment and require the permission of the instructor before a student may enroll. It is expected that students will complete the degree plan process with their advisors and committee before beginning these courses.

FS 5363 Prepracticum—requires that a completed application be submitted to the FT Program Coordinator by the deadline for the semester with a copy of the student's transcript attached; requires completion of the prerequisite courses. The course enrollment code will be sent to students when they are accepted and assigned to a section.

FS 5373 Group Counseling Procedures—requires that a completed application be submitted to the FT Program Coordinator by the deadline for the semester with a copy of the student's transcript attached; requires completion of the prerequisite courses. The course enrollment code will be sent to the students when they are accepted.

FS 5532 and 5542; FS 6532 and 6542 Practicum in Family Therapy—requires that a completed application be submitted to the FT Program Coordinator by the deadline for the semester with a copy of the transcript and the signed degree plan attached; requires the completion of the prerequisite courses. The course enrollment codes will be sent to the students when they are accepted and assigned to a section.

FS 6353 Supervision in Family Therapy—requires that the student be enrolled in the 3rd or 4th semester of Practicum or be already licensed and practicing, since the students will be bringing videotapes of their current family therapy sessions to class. This course also includes the provision of supervision in the Counseling & Family Therapy Clinic for the semester enrolled. Although an application form for this class is not required, the instructor of this doctoral level course has the authority to determine who is or is not eligible to enroll.
