Important Information about Restricted Enrollment Family Therapy Clinical Courses

The following Family Therapy courses have restricted enrollment and require the permission of the instructor before a student may enroll. It is expected that students will complete and *file a degree plan* with their advisors and committee *before* beginning these courses.

FS 5363 Prepracticum-FT—requires that a completed application be submitted to the FT Program Coordinator by the deadline for the semester with a copy of the student's Portal transcript attached; requires completion of the prerequisite courses. The course enrollment code will be sent to students when they are accepted and assigned to a section.

FS 5544 Internship in Family Therapy; FS 6544 Advanced Internship in Family Therapy—requires that a completed application be submitted to the FT Program Coordinator by the deadline for the semester with a copy of the transcript and the signed degree plan attached; requires the completion of the prerequisite courses. The course enrollment codes will be sent to the students when they are accepted and assigned to a section. The student must apply for the course *each* semester.

FS 6353 Supervision in Family Therapy—requires that the student be enrolled in the 3rd or 4th semester of Advanced Internship in Family Therapy or be already licensed and practicing, since the students will be bringing videotapes of their current family therapy sessions to class. This course also includes the provision of some supervision in the Counseling & Family Therapy Clinic on campus for the semester enrolled. Non-student licensed and practicing mental health professionals in the community may also apply to take the Supervision course. An application form for this class is required and the instructor of this doctoral level course has the authority to determine who is or is not eligible to enroll.

FS 5373 Group Counseling Procedures—requires that a completed application be submitted to the Counseling & Development Program Coordinator by the deadline for the semester with a copy of the student's transcript attached; requires completion of the prerequisite courses. The course enrollment code will be sent to the students when they are accepted. Changed as of 2009—Family Therapy students take Group class in the C&D section and apply through C&D. Ask about their deadlines at least one semester ahead.
