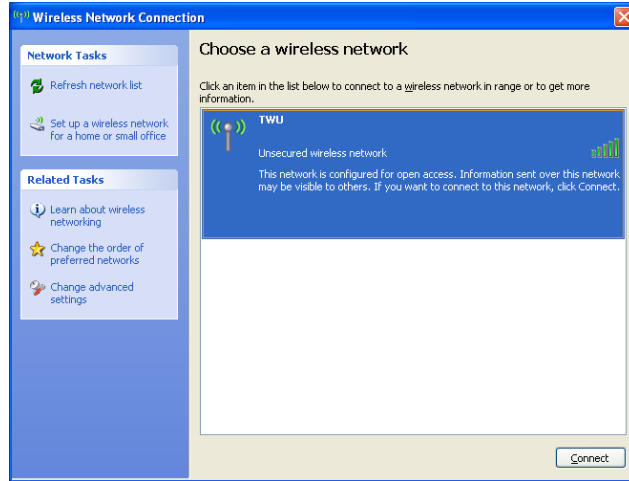


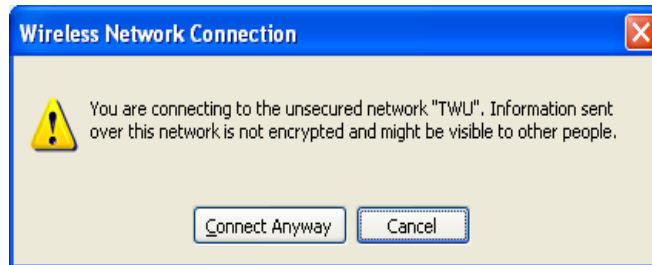
Instructions on How to Connect to TWU's Wireless Network

1. Right click on the wireless network icon on the right corner of your computer screen, and click **View available wireless networks**.

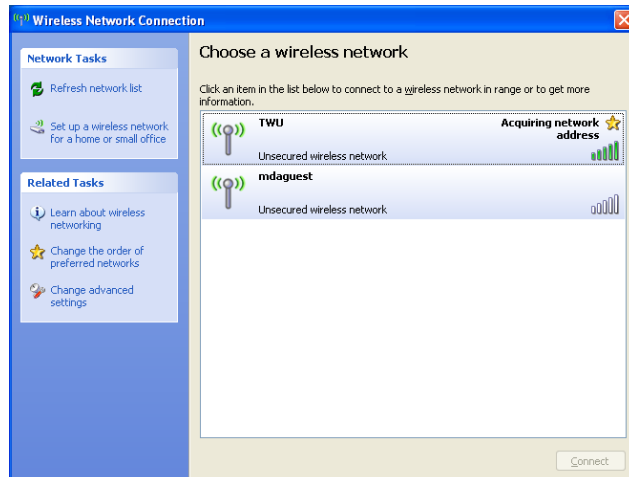
2. Select "TWU" network and click **Connect** button.



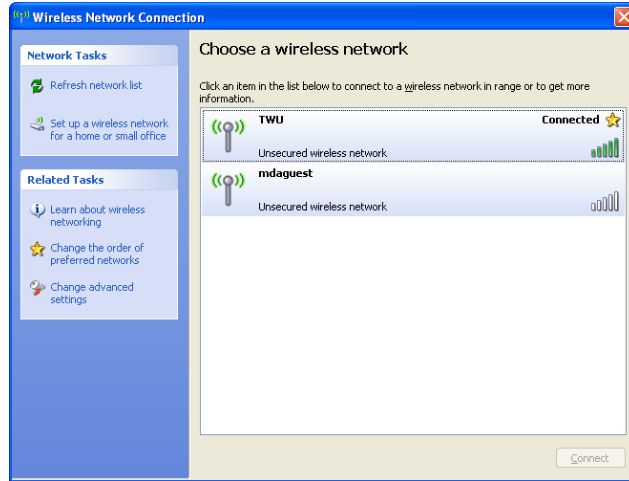
3. Click **Connect Anyway**.



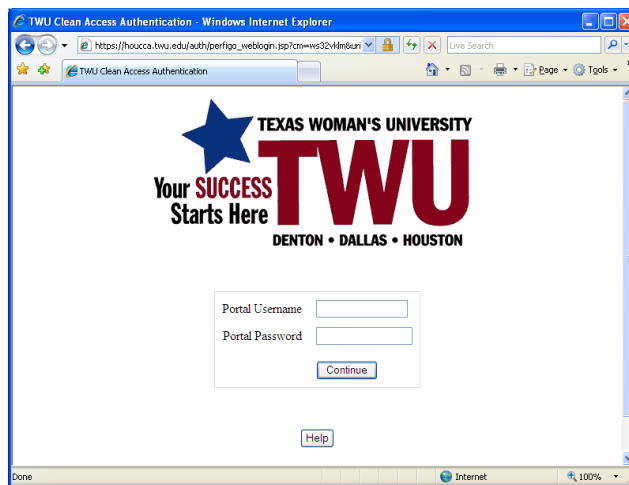
4. Wait for it to connect.



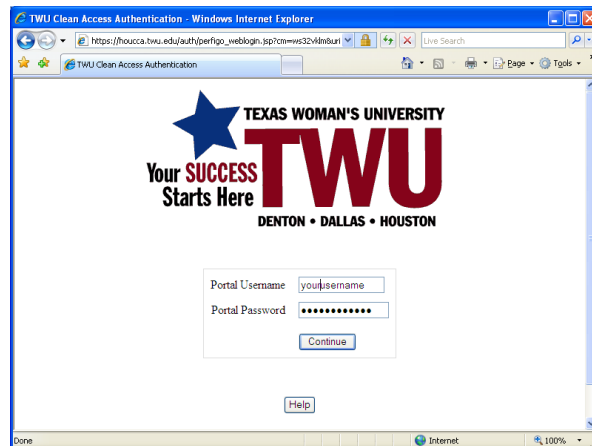
5. It will show **Connected** when it finished connecting to the network.



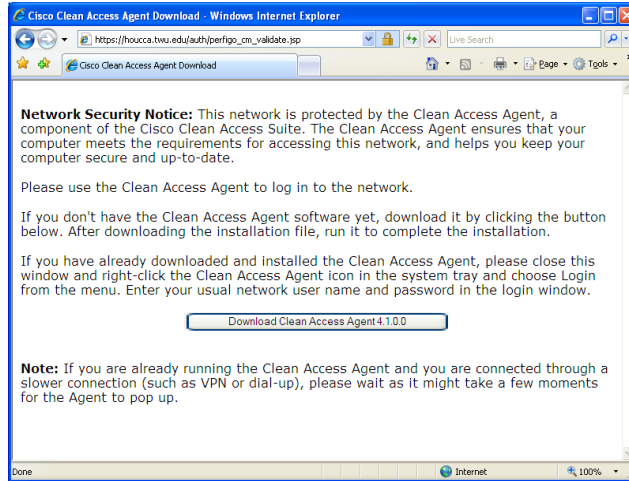
6. Open your Internet browser and you will see a screen like this:



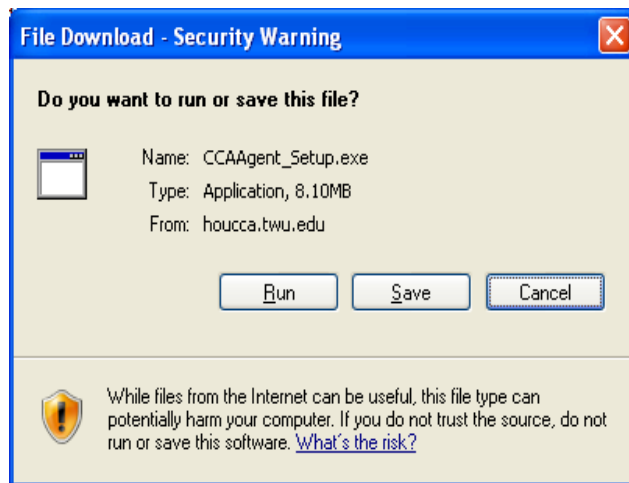
7. Enter your Portal username and password, and click **Continue** button.



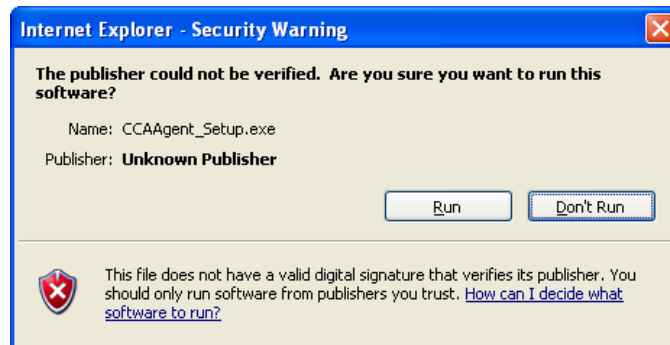
8. The Network Security Notice window pops up. Click **Download Clean Access Agent 4.1.0.0**.



9. When File Download window pops up, click **Run**.



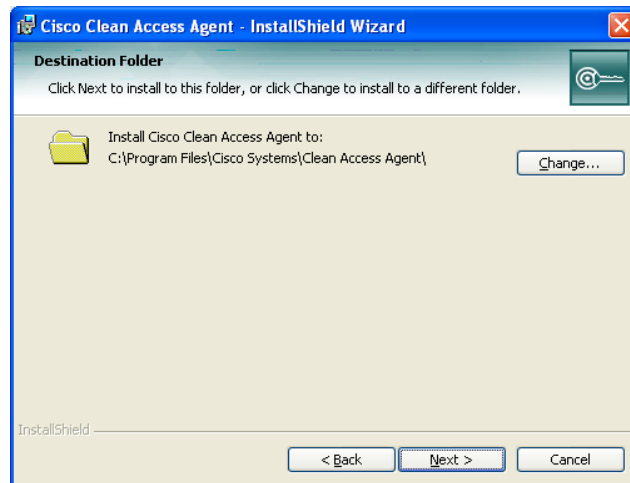
10. Click on **Run** again.



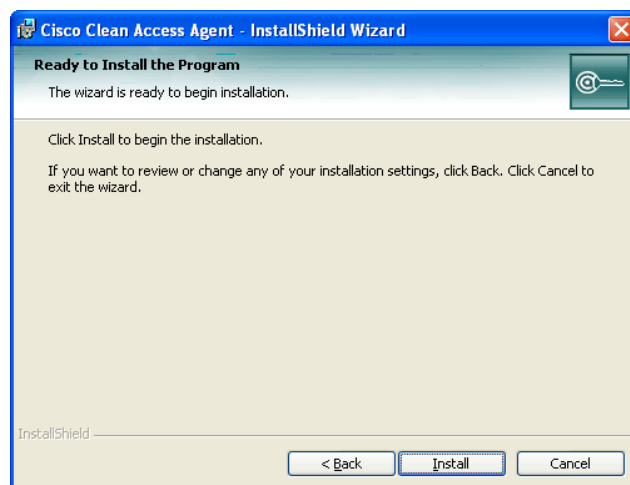
11. Click on **Next**.



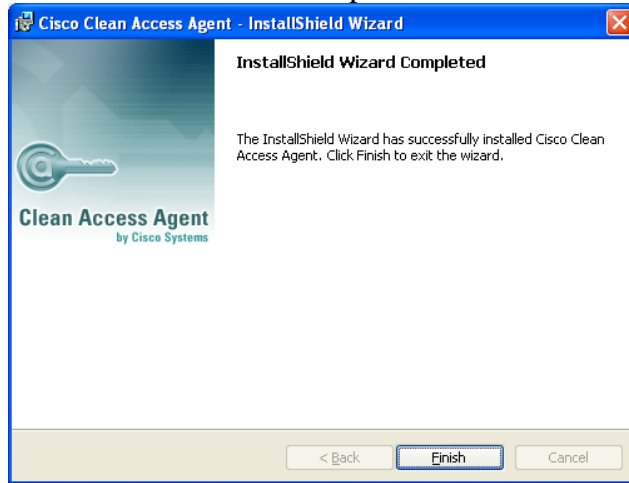
12. Click on **Next** button.



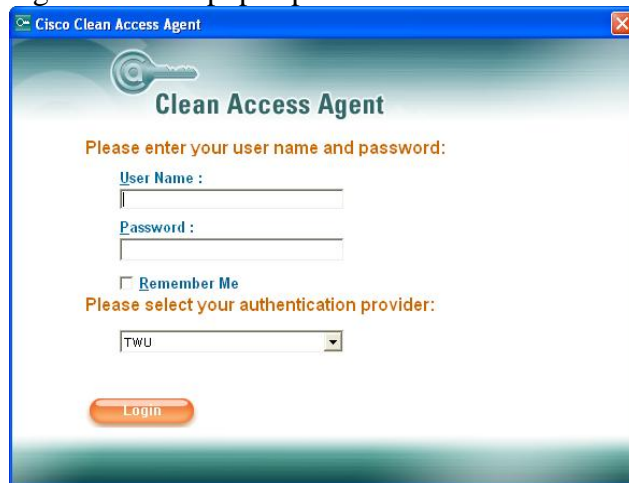
13. Click on **Install**.



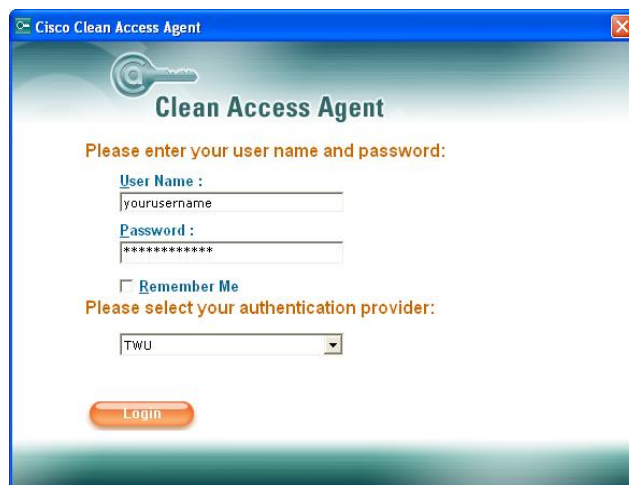
14. Click on **Finish** button after installation is complete.



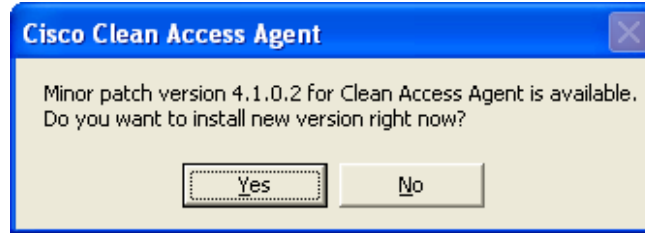
15. Cisco Clean Access Agent window pops up.



16. Enter your Portal username and password. Click **Login** button.



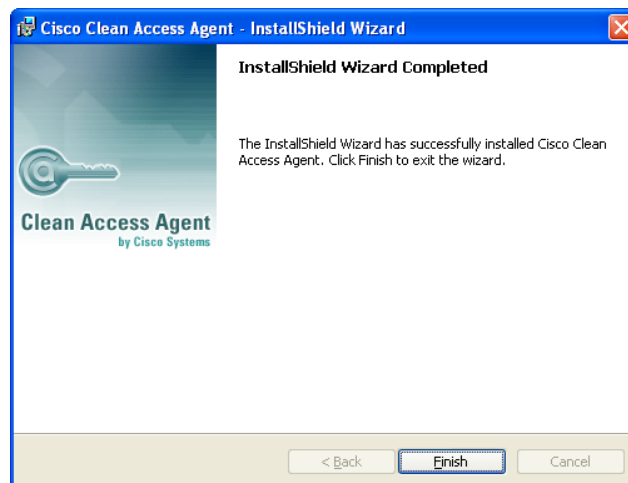
17. Click **Yes**.




18. Click on **Next**.



19. Click **Finish** when it completed.



20. Enter your username and password to login.



21. You will see message “Successfully logged in to the network!” Click **OK**.



22. Now you can start browsing Internet.

Note: You must have rights to install Cisco Clean Access Agent in your computer.

**For Windows Vista, make sure to uncheck “Check for server certificate revocation” under Tools > Internet Options > Advanced > Security.*
