

Dr. Robert S. Martin Appointed Professor Emeritus

The Honorable Dr. Robert S. Martin, retired TWU SLIS Professor and Lillian Bradshaw Endowed Chair in Library Science, was accorded the status of Professor Emeritus by the TWU Board of Regents in recognition of his distinguished service to Texas Woman's University and the College of Professional Education.

Dr. Martin was TWU SLIS Professor and Interim Director from 1999 to 2001, when he was appointed as Director of the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS). In 2005, Dr. Martin returned to TWU SLIS as Professor and Lillian Bradshaw Endowed Chair, until his retirement in August 2008. In November 2008, Dr. Martin was honored by former President George W. Bush with a Presidential Citizens Medal. Dr. Martin continues his service to the library profession by serving on the Advisory Committee on the Electronic Records Archive of the National Archives and Records Administration, on the National Council on the Humanities, and on other advisory boards.
