

Options for Temporary School Librarian Certification

1. Emergency Permit Requirements: (initiated through school district)

- Texas teaching certificate
- Two (2) years classroom (public or private accredited) teaching experience
- Completion of six (6) hours of applicable coursework
- Renewed on a yearly basis, with coursework to be completed within three (3) years
- State mandates minimum of six (6) course hours to be completed each year (school district may require more)
- School district grants annual renewal based on student progress

2. Probationary Certification Requirements: (initiated through university)

- Admitted to SLIS
- Have completed or be currently enrolled in LS 5083 (formerly LS 5813) with degree plan on file
- Two (2) years classroom (public or private accredited) teaching experience
- Student service record must be submitted to the TWU Student Support office showing teaching requirement has been met.
- Renewed on a yearly basis, with coursework to be completed within three (3) years
- University recommends annual renewal based on student progress
