The *Myrtle Gebert Isensee Endowment for Library Sciences* was established through the estate plans of Mrs. Myrtle Gebert Isensee. Mrs. Isensee was born to August and Hattie Jochen Gebert on October 5, 1916, and grew up in Schulenburg, Texas. She graduated from TWU, then Texas State College for Women, in 1939 with a Bachelor of Arts in Library Science. As a student attending the University, she was very involved on campus serving as an officer in the Library Science Club as well as a student advisor and assistant. After graduation, Mrs. Isensee taught in the Texas public school system for many years including teaching in Atlanta, Lockhart and Schulenburg, Texas.

Mrs. Isensee volunteered extensively at the Schulenburg Public Library for over 25 years and was named Schulenburg's Citizen of the year in 1989 for her service to the community. Mrs. Isensee passed away on July 10, 2008, and was predeceased in death by her loving husband, George W. Isensee.
