During her administration the Golden Book was established and funds were designated towards the Endowment Fund. Under the leadership of Mrs. Carleton the Texas club women, along with club women from across the country, were successful in petitioning the Postmaster to issue a GFWC commemorative stamp for the 75th anniversary of the Federation. Library work was a chief interest of Mrs. Carleton and she encouraged existing scholarships to be used in Library Science programs.
