The Slogan of Mrs. Dibrell's administration was "Betterment of Home and Community." She used her acquaintances in the Texas legislature to accomplish her goals, which led her administration to be known as "the legal one." Mrs. Dibrell, as TFWC President, purchased the Elizabet Ney Art Studio upon the death Mrs. Ney so that the works contained inside the studio and the studio itself could become an art museum.
