Under the Hertzberg administration the Federation motto, "In small things liberty, in large things unity, in all things charity," was adopted. Her administration stressed bringing parents and teachers together in education and better public school efficiency. Also under Mrs. Hertzberg's administration standing committees were changed to departments of work, the pecan was adopted as the Federation tree, the state endowment fund was created and better laws for married women were encouraged and adopted.
