The theme of Mrs. Hughes administration was "Our American heritage – Right, Responsibilities, Respect, Reverence." During Mrs. Hughes administration the City of Austin threatened to file suit against the TFWC unless \$22,658.35 in back taxes on the Federation Headquarters was paid. A resolution was presented to sell the headquarters building, but was defeated by a ballot vote of 113 – 158. A new scroll "Friends of Federation" listing names of donors of \$100 or more was started with monies to go to the Headquarters Endowment Fund. Many fundraising efforts were undertaken to finance problems with the TFWC headquarters. This administration also saw the saving of the "Big Thicket."
