The theme of Mrs. Perry's administration was "A Pattern of Tomorrow's World." Her goals for the Federation were to provide clubs assistance through the establishment of the Program Building Files and to increase the circulation of the Federation News. The name of the Magazine was changed during this time to The Texas Clubwoman. State projects during Mrs. Perry's administration included cancer control, international students and junior community projects. After her administration, Mrs. Perry was active in raising over 10 million dollars in war bonds during the "Buy a Bomber" program and succeeded in having fleet of bombers named for Texas Clubs.
