The theme of Mrs. Potter's administration was "Home, Education and Texas." During her administration she led the Texas women in raising \$20,000 for the local expenses of the 1928 GFWC Biennial that was held in San Antonio that year. Mrs. Potter was known for traveling the state during her administration and is said to have given hundreds of speeches to groups and over the radio. Her administration stressed citizenship training, law observance, billboard restrictions, irrigation and flood control, health training and narcotics education in schools
