The goals set up by Mrs. Williford-Whatley for her administration were: to increase the number of informed voters on the proposed Texas Constitution through a program called "Poll Power," to make Girlstown, USA a state project, to achieve 510 c3 status for the organization, to create a TFWC Historical Foundation, reaffirm support for the MD Anderson Clinic and to begin programs to prevent rape and crime. This administration worked hard for the passage of rape legislation and passed an emergency resolution calling for the abolition of the Federal Department of Health, Education and Welfare.
