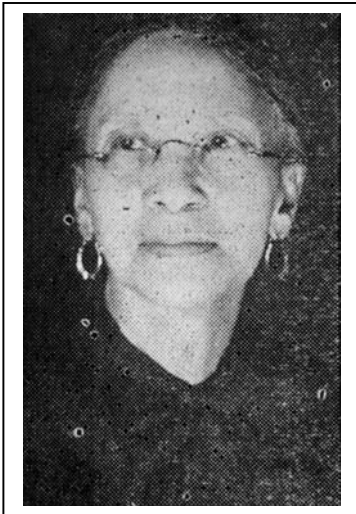


## Mrs. H. E. (Olivia) Williams President 1922-1926

Was a major force in Mothers Clubs. Her three day fund-raiser netted \$100. It was enough to purchase 6 large swings for the public schools.

In 1905 founded the Olivia Williams District located in the extreme northwest corner of Texas. Includes the cities of Texarkana-Texas Arkansas, Atlanta, Jefferson, Marshall, and Tyler.
