Mr. COSTELLO introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Com-  
mittee on Military Affairs

A BILL

To provide for the appointment of female pilots in the Air  
Forces of the Army.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That hereafter during the present war and six months there-  
4 after there shall be included in the Air Forces of the Army  
5 such licensed female pilots as the Secretary of War may  
6 consider necessary, whose qualifications, duties, and assign-  
7 ments shall be in accordance with regulations to be pre-  
8 scribed by the Secretary, and who shall be appointed and  
9 at his discretion removed by the Commanding General of  
10 the Air Forces of the Army, subject to the approval of the  
11 Secretary of War. Those appointed shall be commissioned

1 in the Army of the United States, and shall receive the same  
2 pay and allowances and be entitled to the same rights,  
3 privileges, and benefits as members of the Officers' Reserve  
4 Corps of the Army with the same grade and length of  
5 service.
