The Humphries Award for Dedication to TWU

This award is named for Jesse H. Humphries, a member of the original faculty in 1903. She was named Associate Dean of the college in 1917 and was a professor and director of the department of sociology. She was recognized nationally for her work in education for women. Ms. Humphries was the author of the inscription on the Pioneer Woman statue. A former student wrote after her death in 1944: "She certainly is one of the immortals for she will live on for ages in the lives of the thousands whom she has inspired and those who in their turn have been influenced for good by them."
