During her term as President, a ten-acre tract of land was purchased in San Antonio with \$5500 down and \$700 a month, for the home for delinquent girls.

Hers was a successful fund-raising campaign for the girls home.

The Ethel Ransom Art and Literary Club in Houston was organized in her honor in 1927.
