



## Associate of Applied Science in Nursing to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN to BS)

This curriculum is designed for students who wish to complete or have already completed the Associate of Applied Science Degree of Nursing at Collin County Community College (Collin) and then transfer to Texas Woman's University to complete a B. S. in Nursing. This plan includes completion of the core curriculum graduation requirements and additional nursing prerequisites at Collin. *Field of Study courses are italicized below.* This agreement is also for students who have an active Texas registered nursing license and who desire to take the academic prerequisites at Collin in order to enter the baccalaureate nursing program at TWU. This plan also gives the student the opportunity to earn an Associate of Arts/ Science at Collin.

*All students must complete six credit hours in approved Global Perspectives (GP) courses, either in the core, major/minor courses or electives (TWU graduation requirement). A current list of COLLIN equivalencies may be found at <http://www.twu.edu/admissions/transfer-list.asp>.*

**NOTE:** To enter the TWU Nursing Program, students must have a minimum grade point average of at least 2.0 on the required non-nursing lower division courses. Class space is limited and admission into the nursing courses is competitive. See TWU General Catalog for other requirements and deadlines.
