

## APPENDIX B

### PHD/OT CORE COURSE ROTATION \*

Two courses are offered as organized classes each fall/spring semesters. They are identified below as Course A & B. They are delivered in a hybrid format with two face-to-face workshops each semester. Course A/B on-campus workshops are held sequentially on the same long weekend. Fall semesters: the 1<sup>st</sup> on campus workshop occurs approximately two weeks after the regular semester begins and the 2<sup>nd</sup> workshop in early December. Spring semesters: the 1<sup>st</sup> on campus workshop will occur approximately two weeks after the regular semester begins and the 2<sup>nd</sup> workshop in the latter part of April. Summer semesters: the 1<sup>st</sup> on campus workshop will occur within the 1<sup>st</sup> two weeks of June and the 2<sup>nd</sup> workshop in early August. Each workshop will meet for 1.5 days of class time at each face-to-face meeting. Specific workshop dates/times/faculty will be announced with three months advance notice.
