

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I apply to the program?

You must apply and be accepted to Texas Woman's University to enroll in the certificate program. You must submit transcripts from your bachelorette degree and/or master's degree that show evidence of an Occupational Therapy degree. Because this is a recognized certificate program and not a degree program, you will apply as a certificate student.
