Apply for GI Bill Benefits

Once the Department of Veteran Affairs processes your GI Bill application they will mail you a "Certification of Eligibility" letter. You will need to turn in a copy of this letter to TWU's Veterans Program.

Register for class

Once you have received your acceptance letter to TWU, meet with your [academic advisor](#) and create your Pioneer Portal account. After you have registered for classes you will need to submit the [Veterans Intent to register form](#).

*It will take the VA approximately six to eight weeks, from the first day of class, to process your application, certify your enrollment and payout your education claim.
