◆ DUE IN OFFICE, ADMISSION & REGISTRATION (1) ONE YEAR PRIOR TO THE SEMESTER OF GRADUATION.

PROCEDURES:

1. The student will file TWU transcript/grade report evaluations at the time suggested by the advisor.
2. The student will list on this form all courses satisfactorily completed and those to be completed, by course numbers. The advisor will forward the form to the Dept. Chair.
3. If approval is granted, the Department Chair will forward the form to the Minor Advisor.
4. If approval is granted, the Minor Advisor will forward to the Director of Teacher Education and Certification.
5. If approval is granted, the Director of Teacher Education and Certification will forward this form to the Dean.
6. If approval is granted, the Dean will forward the form to the Registrar's Office at least one year prior to the expected date of graduation.
7. The Department Chair will be the sole authority for authorizing substitutions in the list of major courses.
8. The Director of Teacher Education and Certification is the sole authority for authorizing any and all substitutions for certification.
9. The Registrar's Office will determine that legal and university-wide graduation requirements have been or will be satisfied for graduation.
10. The Registrar's Office will notify the candidate of steps to be followed for graduation.
11. The Director of Teacher Education and Certification will determine whether legal and university certification requirements have been or will be met for graduation.
12. The catalog carrying the date a student was first enrolled in an accredited college or university may dictate the requirements or graduation for a five-year period. Beyond this time a new catalog must be consulted. The Advisor and student should agree on the catalog date to be used and enter this information in the space designated "Catalog" on this form. This rule may be superseded by state law.

NOTES:

- ◆ By state law, the candidate must have credit for six (6) semester hours of American History – Texas History may substitute for (3) semester hours.
- ◆ By state law the candidate must have credit for six (6) semester hours of Federal and State Constitutions. Six (6) semester hours of ROTC may be substituted.
- ◆ Major catalog defines a minimum of thirty (30) semester hours. One half (½) of advanced hours must have been completed at TWU.
- ◆ BA degree requires three (3) semester hours of Mathematics, six (6) semester hours of Science, three (3) semester hours of Multicultural, Three (3) semester hours of Women's Studies.
- ◆ BA degree requires three (3) semester hours of Fine Arts in addition to the major requirements.
- ◆ BA degree requires fifteen (15) semester hours in a selected content Area chosen from at least three of the following areas:
 - Environmental Studies, Foreign Language, Health & Fitness
 - Philosophy, Social Sciences.
 - An additional course in Mathematics, Literature, Visual Arts or Performing Arts.
- ◆ If Visual Arts hours are selected as part of the fifteen (15) selected content area, these courses may not count as part of the major.
- ◆ BA degree requires six (6) semester hours in interdisciplinary courses, but not necessarily additional courses.
- ◆ A minimum of 36 advanced hours is required for any bachelor's degree.
- ◆ Thirty (30) of the last 36 hours must be completed at TWU.
- ◆ A student who holds a valid bachelor's degree from another Accredited college or university and who wishes to earn a second Bachelor's degree at TWU must complete the following legal Requirements:
 - (6) semester hrs American History
 - (6) semester hrs Nat'l & State Governments
 - (36) semester hrs advanced studies and meet departmental residence requirements.
- ◆ Candidates for teacher certification should check with faculty advisors, TWU catalog, the College of Education and Human and Director of Teacher Educ. & Certification about requirements.
