- Day 2 enrollment numbers for spring Graduate enrollment is down 254 students (-4.4%) compared to this time last year.
- Completed applications for summer are up 115 students (27%) with accepted students up 31 students (38%).

- For fall, completed applications are up 242 students (42%) with accepted students up 65 students (102%).
- Admissions is planning Pioneer Preview Day for Saturday, February 25.
