### I. Call Academic Affairs Committee Meeting to Order

With a quorum present, Regent Hyde, Chair of the Academic Affairs Committee, called the meeting to order at 3:37 p.m.

Regent Hyde welcomed Regents Ellen Amirkhan, Bernadette Coleman, Jill Jester, Kathleen Wu, and Student Regent Jianna Covarelli to the Board.

### II. Consider Approval of the Minutes of the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting of May 16, 2023

<u>Motion to Approve Minutes:</u> Regent Shepard motioned and Regent Coleman seconded. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

The minutes of the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting of May 16, 2023 were approved as submitted.

### III. Agenda

Regent Hyde said that the Board would now take up the Agenda Items as listed.

<u>Motion to Take up Agenda Items as Listed:</u> Regent Coleman motioned and Regent Shepard seconded. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

## Item A. Report on Faculty Highlight, College of Arts and Sciences, School of the Arts and Design, Dance – Denton Campus

Dr. O. Finley Graves, Interim Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost, introduced Dr. Ilana Morgan, Associate Professor of Dance. Dr. Morgan provided a presentation to the Board on her current research topic of dance learning for youth in detention. Dr. Morgan explained that her dance

learning program is part of the Denton County Post-Adjudication Courage to Change Program, which is funded by a two year National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) Arts Education Grant. Dr. Morgan described the detention center environment and her research at the center. She concluded her report by presenting that her findings revealed that the Courage to Change Program provides juveniles with agency over space, expression of identity and freedom, opportunities to make artistic choices, allows collaboration with different people, and develops skills for creating from the unknown and creating the self.

### IV. Adjourn Academic Affairs Committee Meeting to Executive Closed Session

Regent Hyde then announced that the Committee would recess to Executive Closed Session for the purposes of Deliberations Regarding Personnel Matters Relating to Appointment, Employment, Evaluation, Reassignment Duties, Discipline, or Dismissal of Public Officers or Employees pursuant to Section 551.074 of the Texas Government Code. Regent Hyde stated the Committee will hear a recommendation to approve Emeritus and Emerita faculty and a recommendation to approve faculty for tenure.
