**Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene**

This curriculum is designed for students currently in the Dental Hygiene Program at Temple College (TC) in pursuit of an Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene who wish to simultaneously pursue a Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene from Texas Woman's University. These courses have been designed to blend with and enhance the TC AAS-DH curriculum and allow decreased time necessary to the BSDH degree.
