

Annual Outcome Data Report

Within the Department of Family Sciences, at Texas Woman's University, two Counseling Programs are accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP, 2009): Master of Science with an emphasis in Clinical Mental Health Counseling and Master of Science in School Counseling.

2017 Program Graduates

In 2017 twenty-six students graduated from Texas Woman's University. Of the twenty-six, six were in the School Counseling Program and twenty were in the Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program.

The Master of Science in Clinical Mental Health Counseling requires the completion of 61 semester hours at the graduate level. During the period from Summer 2016 through Spring 2017, 20 students graduated from this program. This approximately represents an 87% graduation rate.

The Master of Science in School Counseling requires the completion of 61 semester hours at the graduate level. During the period from Summer 2016 through Spring 2017, 6 students graduated from this program. The program maintains a 100% completion rate among those students seeking the MS with School Counseling emphasis. Similarly, these same students enjoy a 100% pass rate for the School Counselor TExES, the state-level certification examination.

Currently Enrolled Students

The Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program currently has 114 students enrolled while the Professional School Counseling Program has 18 students currently enrolled. Both programs have a fairly even distribution of students across the time-span of the graduate program.

Record of Test Performance

The majority of students who graduated in 2017 and have taken the National Counselor Examination for Licensure have passed the exam; the overall pass rate for Texas Woman's University is 95%. Students in the Professional School Counseling Program have passed the TExES Exam with 100% pass rate.

Acceptance Rate

Of the applicants interviewed and evaluated over the past calendar year, 70% have been offered admission. The admission process includes an evaluation of credentials, essays, as well as both group and individual interviews.
