Student Achievement Criteria

Average Time to Degree: The average time to graduate with a Family Therapy PhD, for students entering with a Master's degree in Family Therapy, is **3.35 years**. The average time to graduate with a Family Therapy PhD, for students entering with a Master's degree in a discipline other than Family Therapy, is **7.39 years**. The average length of time to complete the Family Therapy PhD, across graduating students beginning in academic year 2006-07 or later, is **5.37 years**.
