BGS Graduation Requirements

Students are required to complete a minimum of 30 hours at TWU to meet residency requirements. BGS students are required to complete one half of each concentration area at TWU.

Minimum GPA of 2.0 is required for completion of the degree; both cumulative and institutional.

BGS students are required to complete each concentration area course with a grade of C or better.

BGS students are required to complete 36 advanced hours of major coursework. 18 advanced hours must be completed at TWU

Minimum total number of hours for degree is 120 completed hours.
