- Abstract title
- Purpose of the project/study
- Significance
- Design/plan/methods
- Findings
- Conclusion and implications for nursing practice, education, or research
- Do not put author names on this document
- Email page 1 form and above information to foundersdayabstracts@twu.edu

Abstract Guidelines:

- Subject material must be significant to nursing
- Abstracts must be free of commercial bias
- Length is limited to 400 words or less
- Do not include charts, tables or references
- Evidence-based abstracts and other projects must identify the plan/methods
- Research abstracts must identify the design
- Do not include author names on the abstract
- All abstracts will receive a peer review
- Accepted abstracts will be published online on the Sigma Beta Beta Chapter website
- Accepted posters will be judged on site and the winner will be announced at the conference
- Accepted podium presentations will be 15-30 minutes in length

Notification of Acceptance

All notifications will be sent by email. It is the submitter's responsibility to ensure that a valid email address is correct and current. TWU College of Nursing and Beta Beta Houston are not responsible for confirmations not received due to incorrect contact information. An email confirmation will be sent upon successful submission of an abstract.
