The fellowship is not intended to fund conferences, seminars, or workshops that are content-oriented (e.g., legal issues, faculty evaluations, budget development, scheduling, etc.), though these topics may be part of a broader program offering on leadership development which has a primary focus on self-awareness and self-development.
