**Associate of Applied Science in Nursing and Associate of Arts/Science Degree  
to  
Bachelor of Science Degree with a Major in Nursing (RN to BS)**

This curriculum is designed for students who wish to complete or have already completed the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing at Collin College (Collin) and are core complete, i.e., completed an AA or AS, they then transfer to Texas Woman's University to complete a B. S. in Nursing. This plan includes completion of the core curriculum graduation requirements and additional nursing prerequisites at Collin. *Field of Study courses are italicized below.* Students in good standing may take NURS3643 and BIOL4344 prior to passing the NCLEX exam. However, they may not progress to NURS3614 or any other NURS course without first passing the NCLEX exam. This agreement is also for students who have an active Texas registered nursing license and who desire to take the academic prerequisites at Collin in order to enter the baccalaureate nursing program at TWU.

*All students must complete six credit hours in approved Global Perspectives (GP) courses, either in the core, major/minor courses or electives (TWU graduation requirement). See below.*

**NOTE:** To enter the TWU Nursing Program, students must have a minimum grade point average of at least 2.0 on the required non-nursing lower division courses. See *TWU General Catalog* for other requirements and deadlines.
