Rules

1. Competition is open to current TWU art students ONLY.
2. All entries must have been completed within the past year (Fall 2017 – Fall 2018). Unfinished, wet, or potentially hazardous work will not be accepted. Entries must arrive ready to be installed (see below for details).
- 3. Each student may enter up to two pieces. Each piece must be marked on the back with the student's name and artwork title. There is no entry fee.**
4. Entries will be accepted in the East Gallery during the following times ONLY:

Monday, October 8th, 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM Tuesday, October 9th, 1:00 PM – 5:00 PM

5. Each artist must fill out an entry form. This is available online (www.twu.edu/visual-arts/galleries/exhibitions-and-programming/) in the Art Office #107FAB, or outside the Gallery office #108FAB. PLEASE COMPLETE FORM IN ADVANCE.
6. Jurying will take place Thursday, October 11th. Works not accepted will be available for pickup in the atrium and hallways Friday, October 12 from 10:00am – 5:00pm. Works left after this time will be discarded.
7. Accepted works will be available for pickup from the galleries on:

Monday, November 19th 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM and Tuesday, November 20th, 1:00 PM – 5:00 PM.

TWU Department of Visual Arts Gallery is not responsible for work left after the pick-up deadlines.

8. All work must be ready to hang in the show. Gallery will not provide or install hanging hardware on artwork.

➤2-D work must be ready to hang on the wall with proper hanging hardware. If framed, with Plexiglas glazing (unless work conceptually requires other method). Gallery wrapped canvas with a wire or D-ring hangers on the back. NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS. THERE MUST BE A WIRE OR D-RING HANGERS ON THE BACK. ➤2-D Graphic Design work – Must be presented in a professional manner commonly accepted in Graphic Design.

Must be ready to install – WIRE OR D-RING HANGERS ON THE BACK. ➤Installation Pieces - It is recommended that all installation work include photographs or digital images of how the completed work will look once installed.

If your work is accepted into the show you will be required to aid with the installation. Please check with the Gallery Coordinator if you have questions about installation work.

➤3-D work must be ready to place on a pedestal, shelf, or floor. It is recommended that all pieces too large to bring to entry include photographs or digital images of how the completed work will look once installed. If your work is accepted into the show you will be required to aid with the installation.

➤Video work – You will need to arrange for your piece to be ready to view on the day the show is juried. Please see the Gallery Coordinator for more information on entering video work.
